Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: December 13, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review with less than the required 45-day notice because the jurisdiction determined that emergency circumstances required expedited review. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

ORDINANCE #659

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF CARLTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP AND ZONING MAP AN DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Carlton received a request to amend the Comprehensive Plan designation and rezone an approximately 5,000 square foot property, identified as Township 3S, Range 4W, Section 21AC, Tax Lot 1500; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located within the Carlton city limits, is designated as Commercial on the Carlton Comprehensive Plan Map, and is zoned Commercial Business; and

WHEREAS, a request was made to change the Comprehensive Plan Map designation to Residential and to change the zoning on the property to Suburban Residential;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing to consider the request on September 7, 2006 at which time the public was given full opportunity to be present and heard on the matter; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the public hearing, the Planning Commission voted to recommend that the City Council approve the request; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing to consider the request on October 9, 2006 at which time the public was given full opportunity to be present and heard on the matter; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the public hearing, the City Council voted to approve the request; and

WHEREAS, proper notice of the said public hearings was given to the public pursuant to applicable state statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Carlton hereby adopts the findings of fact set forth in the staff report dated August 30, 2006;


NOW THEREFORE; The people of the City of Carlton ordain as follows;

SECTION 1. The Comprehensive Plan Map designation for the subject property is hereby changed from Commercial to Residential.

SECTION 2. The zoning designation for the subject property is hereby changed from Commercial Business to Suburban Residential.

SECTION 3. Emergency Clause. The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace, and safety of the City of Carlton that this ordinance take

effect at once, and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
