Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: September 22, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).


If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

- 4. Submittal of this Notice of Adoption must include the text of the amendment plus adopted findings and supplementary information.
- 5. The deadline to appeal will not be extended if you submit this notice of adoption within five working days of the final decision. Appeals to LUBA may be filed within **TWENTY-ONE** (21) days of the date, the Notice of Adoption is sent to DLCD.
- 6. In addition to sending the Notice of Adoption to DLCD, you must notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision.

Ordinance # 253

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND ZONING MAP ADOPTED JUNE 20, 2001 TO DESIGNATE ADDITIONAL LANDS AS INDUSTRIAL (M) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the City of Moro received a application to amend the City's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map from Azure Farms to designate property they own in the City as Industrial and;

Whereas, the City accepted the application and properly notified the Department of Land Conservation and Development as a proposed Post Acknowledgement Plan Amendment procedure and;

Whereas, the City of Moro caused notices to be sent to adjoining property owners as required by Ordinance and caused notice to be published in the local newspaper and;

Whereas, a Staff Report was prepared and made available by the City's Contract Planner and:

Whereas, the City Council conducted a public hearing beginning at 7:00 p.m. on August 15, 2006 at the close of the public hearing the City Council moved unanimously to approve the proposed Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map;

Therefore, the City of Moro does hereby ordain:

- 1. The Staff Report regarding the proposed Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map Amendment is hereby incorporated into this order as a findings document.
- 2. The City's Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map dated August 15, 2006 showing the Map Amendment for Tax Lot 300 of Sherman County Assessors Map 1S-17-18AB designating the property as "Industrial" (M) is hereby adopted.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE In as much as the economic well being and thus the safety health and welfare of the citizens of Moro is involved and it is in the City's best interest to allow the immediate development of this property by Azure Farms, an emergency is declared to exist. This Ordinance shall be in full force an effect upon its passage by the City Council.
