Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: March 29, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

ORDINANCE NO. 1311

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1286 (TOLEDO MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17) TO REVISE AND ESTABLISH ZONING REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Toledo adopted Ordinance 1286, the Toledo Zoning Ordinance codified as Title 17 of the Toledo Municipal Code, in April 4, 2001, and acknowledge by the State of Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development on June 19, 2002;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1286 allows for amendments that may be necessary from time to time to reflect changing community conditions, needs and desires, to correct mistakes, or to address changes in the law;

WHEREAS, with the passage of time, various code sections require updating;

WHEREAS, this will provide consistency with proposed changes to Toledo Municipal Code Chapter 8.08 (Temporary Uses and Structures and Recreational Vehicles);

WHEREAS, the community development department has requested updates;

WHEREAS, the Toledo Planning Commission prepared a draft of the zoning ordinance revisions to be considered by the City Council and a public hearing was held on February 8, 2006, at which time, the Planning Commission sent forward the proposed zoning ordinance revisions to the City Council for a public hearing and adoption,

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing after proper notification on the proposed zoning ordinance revisions on March 1, 2006, and the City Council has determined that a zoning ordinance revision is in the best interest of the citizens of Toledo,

WHEREAS, implementation of the zoning ordinance revisions as soon as possible is in the public interest and necessary for the peace, health, convenience, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Toledo,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TOLEDO ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Code Section 17.16.020(L) is amended to read as follows:

"L. Temporary street vendors/seasonal commercial uses not to exceed six months."

Section 2. Code Section 17.20.020(Q) is amended to read as follows:

"Q. Temporary street vendors/seasonal commercial uses not to exceed six months."

Section 3. Code Section 17.24.020 shall be amended, adding the following item:

"R. Temporary street vendors/seasonal commercial uses not to exceed six months."

Section 4. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as the provisions herein contained are necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, convenience, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Toledo, Lincoln County, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
