The Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) received the attached notice of adoption. Copies of the adopted plan amendment are available for review at DLCD offices in Salem, the applicable field office, and at the local government office.

Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: May 7, 2007

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

Annexation Ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. 2132

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN LANDS TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY, OUTLINING THE NEW BOUNDARIES, DESCRIBING SAID PROPERTY, WITHDRAWING SAID LANDS FROM THE UMATILLA COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT, AND DESIGNATING ZONING.

THE CITY OF HERMISTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following described property be and the same is annexed to the City of Hermiston, withdrawn from the Umatilla County Library District due to annexation, and the City zoning map is expanded to include said property as Single-family Residential (R-1); to-wit:

The north half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 4 North, Range 28 East, Willamette Meridian, County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, lying east of the easterly high waterline of the Umatilla River.

And also including all right of way of County Road No. 1247 (NW 11th Street) located north of the north line of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter, Section 3, Township 4 North, Range 28 and the north line of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 28 and south of the southerly right of way line of County Road No. 1275 (First Place/River Road). All being east of the Willamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon.

SECTION 2. The findings of fact as adopted by the City Council on December 18, 2006 are incorporated herein by reference.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The city recorder shall promptly transmit a record of annexation proceedings to the Secretary of State and notify the County Clerk and County Assessor of the change in boundary

SECTION 4. The effective date of this ordinance shall be the thirtieth day after enactment.

SECTION 5. This annexation shall be complete when all necessary documents have been accepted and filed by the Secretary of State.
