Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: May 1, 2007

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-02

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2005-02 AND REENACTING THE PREVIOUS DENSITY RANGE FOR THE R-1 ZONING DISTRICT.

The City of Sandy ordains as follows:

- Section 1. Ordinance 2005-02 amending the density range for the Low Density Residential (R-1) zone is hereby repealed.
- Section 2. Page 5 of the Sandy Comprehensive Plan related to the Low Density Residential Plan Designation and the Low Density Residential Zoning District is amended to read as it did prior to Ordinance No. 2005-02's adoption, as follows:
 - 3) The Low Density Residential (R-1) district is intended for 5 to 10 dwelling units per gross acre. Intended uses are single family detached and attached units. Duplexes, subject to siting standards, are also allowed in these areas. Low Density Residential districts are located outside village boundaries and on the periphery of the villages.

Section 3. All remaining provisions of the Sandy Comprehensive Plan are hereby reaffirmed in their entirety.
