Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR DEADLINE TO APPEAL: March 20, 2008

This amendment was not submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption. Pursuant to OAR 660-18-060, the Director or any person is eligible to appeal this action to LUBA under ORS 197.830 to 197.845.

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

- 2. Submit one (1) copy of adopted material, if copies are bounded please submit one complete copies of documents and maps.
- 3. Adopted materials must be sent to DLCD not later than five (5) working days following the date of the final decision on the amendment.
- 4. Submittal of this Notice of Adoption must include the text of the amendment plus adopted findings and supplementary information.
- 5. The deadline to appeal will be extended if you do not submit this Notice of Adoption within five working days of the final decision. Appeals to LUBA may be filed within 21 days of the date Notice of Adoption is sent to DLCD.
- 6. In addition to sending Notice of Adoption to DLCD, you must notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision.

Vernonia Ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. 852

An Ordinance Waiving Certain Sections of the Development Regulations to Allow Temporary Emergency Structures to be Placed in the General Commercial Zone and Declaring an Emergency

Whereas, the flood of 2007 caused extensive damage to a large number of residences in this community; and

Whereas, substantial damage assessments have been done under the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) guidelines; and

Whereas, because of the substantial damage done by the flood waters a number of families cannot live in their homes and must therefore seek alternate, temporary living accommodations; and

Whereas, this need for temporary alternate living accommodations can be and will be supplied by FEMA; and

Whereas, a specifically designated zone in the community is not readily available to accommodate a large number of mobile homes other than in a mobile home park and the only mobile home park suffered severe flooding and therefore mobile homes cannot be sited at that location; and

Whereas, the General Commercial Zone (GC) does allow Recreational Vehicle Parks as a Conditional Use and this use is "similar" noting it is for temporary, mobile homes that will be placed in a "park like" setting. The zone also allows as a Conditional Use a use permitted outright or as a conditional use in the General Residential Zone (GR). In the GR Zone detached dwellings are on outright permitted use as are multi-unit dwellings and Manufactured dwelling parks.

Now therefore the City Council ordains as follows,

- 1. an emergency is hereby declared to exist with specific reference to the placement of mobile homes in a General Commercial Zone more specifically property bounded by Maple Street, Highway 47 and Weed Avenue owned by Gordon Smith, 8720 Willowbrook Drive, Tillamook, Oregon 97141, and
- 2. FEMA has reviewed this site and is in the process of contracting with the owner for use of it on a temporary basis. In this process all of the pertinent City Codes will be adhered to including inspections, and
- 3. The City Council fully understands the severity of this unusual act but as an emergency exists it is felt that for the health and welfare of a large section of the population this action is appropriate as it is temporary in nature and mandatory for the stability of this community.
