DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Thursday, May 07, 2009

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

Ordinance No. 2980

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.1.200.M OF TITLE 14 OF THE COTTAGE GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. <u>Purpose.</u> The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Section 3.1.200.M of Title 14 Cottage Grove Development Code to refer to the latest version of the Uniform Fire Code in regards to Fire Access and Turnarounds.
- Section 2. <u>Procedural Compliance</u>. This amendment is in compliance with 14.4.7.500-600 of the Municipal code of the City of Cottage Grove and is based upon the City Council determination, after a Planning Commission public hearing and recommendation, that this amendment is a proper implementation of the comprehensive land use plan and, therefore, is in the public interest and for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cottage Grove.
- Section 3. <u>Amendment.</u> Title 14 of the Cottage Grove Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows (inserted text shown as **bold**, deleted text shown as **strikethrough**):

3.1.200

M. Fire Access and Turnarounds. When required under the Oregon Fire Code, fire access lanes with turnarounds shall be provided. Except as waived in writing by the Fire Marshal, a fire equipment access drive shall be provided for any portion of an exterior wall of the first story of a building that is located more than 150 feet from an existing public street or approved fire equipment access drive. The drive shall contain unobstructed adequate aisle width of 20 feet with paved surface between 14-20 feet, an unobstructed vertical clearance of 13 feet 6 inches and approved turn-around area for emergency vehicles, as shown in Figure 3.1.200.M required by the current adopted Oregon Fire Code. The Fire Marshal may require that fire lanes be marked as "No Stopping/No Parking." For requirements related to cul-de-sacs or dead-end streets, please refer to Section 3.4.100.N.

Section 4. Effectiveness. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days of adoption pursuant to the City Charter and prior to acknowledgement pursuant to ORS 197.625(3)(a).
