DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Thursday, April 01, 2010


This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local

government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. No LUBA Notification to the jurisdiction of an appeal by the deadline, this Plan Amendment is acknowledged.

Ordinance No. 2991

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 14 OF THE COTTAGE GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE, THE CITY WIDE ZONING MAP.

(Map 20-03-28-44 TL 4500 & 4600, Coiner Park expansion)

THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the adopted citywide "zoning map" to identify the rezoning of the following properties shown in the maps attached as Exhibit "A" from R-1 Single Family Low Density Residential to PR Parks & Recreation:

1414 E. Washington (Map 20-03-28-44 TL 4500) 59 S. 15th Street (Map 20-03-28-44 TL 4600)

- Section 2. Procedural Compliance. This amendment is in compliance with Title, 14, Chapter 4.7 of the Municipal Code of the City of Cottage Grove and is based upon the City Council determination, after a Planning Commission public hearing and recommendation, that the zone change (ZC 1-10) is a proper implementation of the City Comprehensive Land Use Plan and, therefore, is in the public interest and serves the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Cottage Grove.
- Section 3. Amendment. The citywide "zoning map" which is a part of Title 14 is hereby amended as follows with respect to the properties described as Map 20-03-28-44 TL 4500 and 4600:

Change the zoning district classification from R-1 Single Family Low Density Residential to PR Parks & Recreation District.
