Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Thursday, December 24, 2009

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

- 4. Submittal of this Notice of Adoption must include the text of the amendment plus adopted findings and supplementary information.
- 5. The deadline to appeal will not be extended if you submit this notice of adoption within five working days of the final decision. Appeals to LUBA may be filed within twenty-one (21) days of the date, the Notice of Adoption is sent to DLCD.
- 6. In addition to sending the Notice of Adoption to DLCD, you must notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision.

ORDINANCE NO. 09-260

An Ordinance Amending the City Of Monroe Comprehensive Plan Map and Zoning Map to Change the Zoning Designation of Certain Land within the City from Industrial (M) to Commercial (C).

WHEREAS, the Monroe Planning Commission held a public hearing on October 12, 2009, on the proposed Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map amendments, and public notice of said meeting was published in the Tri-County News, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Monroe, and the public was offered an opportunity to testify along with statements from various officials and staff and the contents of that meeting have been reduced to written form; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended in favor of the proposed map amendments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on October 26, 2009, on the proposed map amendments, and public notice of said meeting was published in the Tri-County News, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Monroe, and the public was offered the opportunity to testify along with various officials and staff; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2009 the Monroe City Council did vote unanimously to amend the Comprehensive Plan and Zone designations of the subject property and there is a need to update the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Maps of the City;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MONROE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map of the City of Monroe, as adopted, is amended from Industrial (M) to Commercial (C) for that property generally shown on the Benton County Assessor's Map as T14S R5W Section 28DC, Tax Lot 3000, and more particularly described as Parcel 1 of Partition Plat 2009-007, Benton County, Oregon, and shown in "Exhibit A".
- Section 2. The City Council adopts the Findings of Fact as presented at the public hearing and incorporated by reference
 - Section 3. This Ordinance becomes effective thirty days after its adoption.


