Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: March 9, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.625 (1), 197.830 (2), and 197.830 (9) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION *NOTE: WAS ADOPTED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD.

This matter coming regularly before the Board of County Commissioners, and it appearing that Terry Emmert made application for a Comprehensive Plan map amendment and zone change on property described as T2S, R2E, Section 9DA, Tax Lot 9701; W.M., located at the southwest corner of Hwy. 212/224 and Evelyn Street intersection; and

It further appearing that planning staff, by its report dated November 8, 2005, recommended denial of the application; and

It further appearing that the Planning Commission, at its November 14, 2005 meeting, recommended denial of the application; and

It further appearing that after appropriate notice a public hearing was held before the Board of County Commissioners on December 14, 2005, January 11, 2006 and January 18, 2006, at which testimony and evidence were presented, and that a preliminary decision was made by the Board on January 18, 2006;

Based upon the evidence and testimony presented, this Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

- 1. The applicant requests approval of a Comprehensive Plan map amendment from Light Industrial to General Commercial and corresponding zone change from I-2 to C-3.
- 2. This request meets the applicable provisions of the Statewide Planning Goals, Metro Functional Plan, Clackamas County Comprehensive Plan and Zoning and Development Ordinance.
- 3. This application satisfies Comprehensive Plan Commercial Policy 34.0 because the area has a historical commitment to commercial uses. In addition, given the size of the property and uses in the surrounding area, the subject property is more suitable for commercial than for industrial use.
