Appeal Procedures\*

### DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: November 14, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review with less than the required 45-day notice because the jurisdiction determined that emergency circumstances required expedited review. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

\*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

NOTICE OF DECISION October 24, 2006

Morrow County Transportation System Plan 2006 Update:

This notice is to inform you that on October 18, 2006, the Morrow County Court adopted Ordinance Number MC-06-2006 amending the Morrow County Transportation System Plan. Specifically the Court approved the following:

- Change the functional classification of Brenner Canyon Road from Local Road to Minor Collector
- Add the Valby/Brenner Canyon Road project to the "5 to 20 Year Recommended Roadway System Projects" lists in the Morrow County Transportation System Plan (Tables 5-5 and 6-10) and amend the Estimated Total Cost of those project Lists.
- Add the County Line Road project to the "5 to 20 Year Recommended Roadway System Projects" lists in the Morrow County Transportation System Plan (Tables 5-5 and 6-10) and amend the Estimated Total Cost of those project Lists.

The requirements for filing an appeal of the decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) are set forth in ORS 197.830 to 197.845. State law and associated administrative rules promulgated by LUBA describe the period within which any appeal must be filed and the manner in which such an appeal must be commenced. Presently, ORS 197.830(9) requires that a notice of intent to appeal plan or land use regulation amendments adopted pursuant to ORS 197.610 to 197.625 "shall be filed not later than 21 days after notice of the decision sought to be reviewed is mailed or otherwise submitted to parties entitled to notice under ORS 197.615." Notice of this decision was mailed on October 24, 2006. The deadline to appeal is November 15, 2006.

## BEFORE THE MORROW COUNTY COURT OF MORROW COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2006 AMENDMENT TO THE MORROW COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN, SPECIFICALLY TWO ADDITIONS TO THE LONG-TERM PROJECT LISTS. COUNTY ORDINANCE
NO. MC-O6-2006

### THE COUNTY OF MORROW DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, ORS 203.035 authorizes Morrow County to exercise authority within Morrow County over matters of County concern; and

WHEREAS, Morrow County's Comprehensive Land Use Plan was acknowledged on January 30, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Morrow County adopted a Transportation System Plan in 1998 and an update in 2005; and

WHEREAS, a request was filed by the Morrow County Public Works Department on behalf of the Morrow County Road Committee to adopt two additions to the Morrow County Transportation System Plan Long-Term Projects List; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission held two hearings to review the request on August 29, 2006, at the Morrow County School District Building in Lexington, Oregon and on September 26, 2006, at the North Morrow County Annex Building in Irrigon, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission unanimously recommended to the County Court approval of the request and adoption of the additions to the TSP Long-Term Projects List; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court held a hearing to consider the recommendation of the Morrow County Planning Commission on October 18, 2006, at the Port of Morrow County Riverfront Center in Boardman, Oregon;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNTY COURT OF MORROW COUNTY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

### Section 1 Title of Ordinance

This Ordinance shall be known, and may be cited, as "The 2006 Morrow County Transportation System Plan Amendment - Long-Term Project List Update."

### Section 2 Morrow County Transportation System Plan - Amendment

The Morrow County Transportation System Plan shall be amended to include the two new projects on the Long-Term Projects List, specifically Tables 5-5 and 6-10. The updated tables are attached to this adopting ordinance and incorporated as Exhibits 1 and 2.

- Exhibit 1: Amended Table 5-5 Morrow County 5-20 Year Recommended Roadway System Projects
- Exhibit 2: Amended Table 6-10 Morrow County 5-20 Year (Medium Priority) recommended Roadway System Projects

Additionally the Transportation System Plan shall be amended to identify Brenner Canyon Road as a Minor Collector, a change in status from Local Road.

### Section 3 Effective Date

Given that it is the policy of the State of Oregon that time is of the essence in deciding Land Use matters an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective ten (10) day after execution.
