As we complete work on the Whilamut Passage Bridge, we want to extend our deepest gratitude for your patience with the path impacts you experienced. Crews are finishing construction in the Whilamut Natural Area of Alton Baker Park and bicycle and pedestrian paths will return to their permanent configuration this winter.

Construction crews will reopen the closed park paths by Dec. 6, including Pre's Trail and North Walnut Road. We will also remove the fence at the north end of the Knickerbocker Bridge and detour paths in the park this winter.

Path users may experience intermittent path delays or detours as the project team continues installing design enhancements near the Whilamut Passage Bridge.

The Oregon Department of Transportation's goal is to keep the paths free of construction debris, but please continue to use caution while moving through the area.
