Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Friday, February 08, 2013

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

- *<u>NOTE:</u> The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. <u>NO LUBA</u> Notification to the jurisdiction of an appeal by the deadline, this Plan Amendment is acknowledged.

- 3. <u>Send this Form 2 and one complete paper copy (documents and maps) of the adopted amendment to the address below.</u>
- 4. Submittal of this Notice of Adoption must include the final signed ordinance(s), all supporting finding(s), exhibit(s) and any other supplementary information (ORS 197.615).
- 5. Deadline to appeals to LUBA is calculated **twenty-one (21) days** from the receipt (postmark date) by DLCD of the adoption (<u>ORS 197.830 to 197.845</u>).
- 6. In addition to sending the Form 2 Notice of Adoption to DLCD, please also remember to notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision. (ORS 197.615).

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ORDINANCE NO. 4610

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2050, THE ZONING MAP, ZMA 2012-0013, WATERHOUSE POWERLINE PARK SPLIT ZONING MAP AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, on November 28, 2012, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing to consider a City-initiated application to amend Ordinance No. 2050, the Zoning Map, designating two parcels, on the north and south sides of SW Estuary Drive, from split designations of R7 (Urban Standard Density) and R4 (Urban Medium Density) to R4 (Urban Medium Density) for the entirety of the parcels; and

WHEREAS, the quasi-judicial zoning map amendment will change the zoning of the subject parcels, from a split designation of R7 (Urban Standard Density) and R4 (Urban Medium Density) to entirely R4 (Urban Medium Density); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission received and considered the submitted staff report, exhibits, public testimony and staff recommended approval of this zoning map amendment; and

WHEREAS, no appeals were filed with the City; and

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WHEREAS, the Council adopts as to criteria applicable to this request and findings thereon the Planning Division Staff Report dated November 21, 2012, and Planning Commission Land Use Order No. 2306. Now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2050, the Zoning Map, is amended to designate the parcel identified in Section 2 to the zoning designation R4 (Urban Medium Density).


