A thesis is an original and substantial piece of academic research of sufficient quality to be considered for publication in a scholarly venue. An ARP is a significant piece of work intended for publication for a lay or trade audience. The subject is a topic within the fields of journalism or media studies, and the project is presented in various formats, including still photography, video, audio, design, and solely text.
