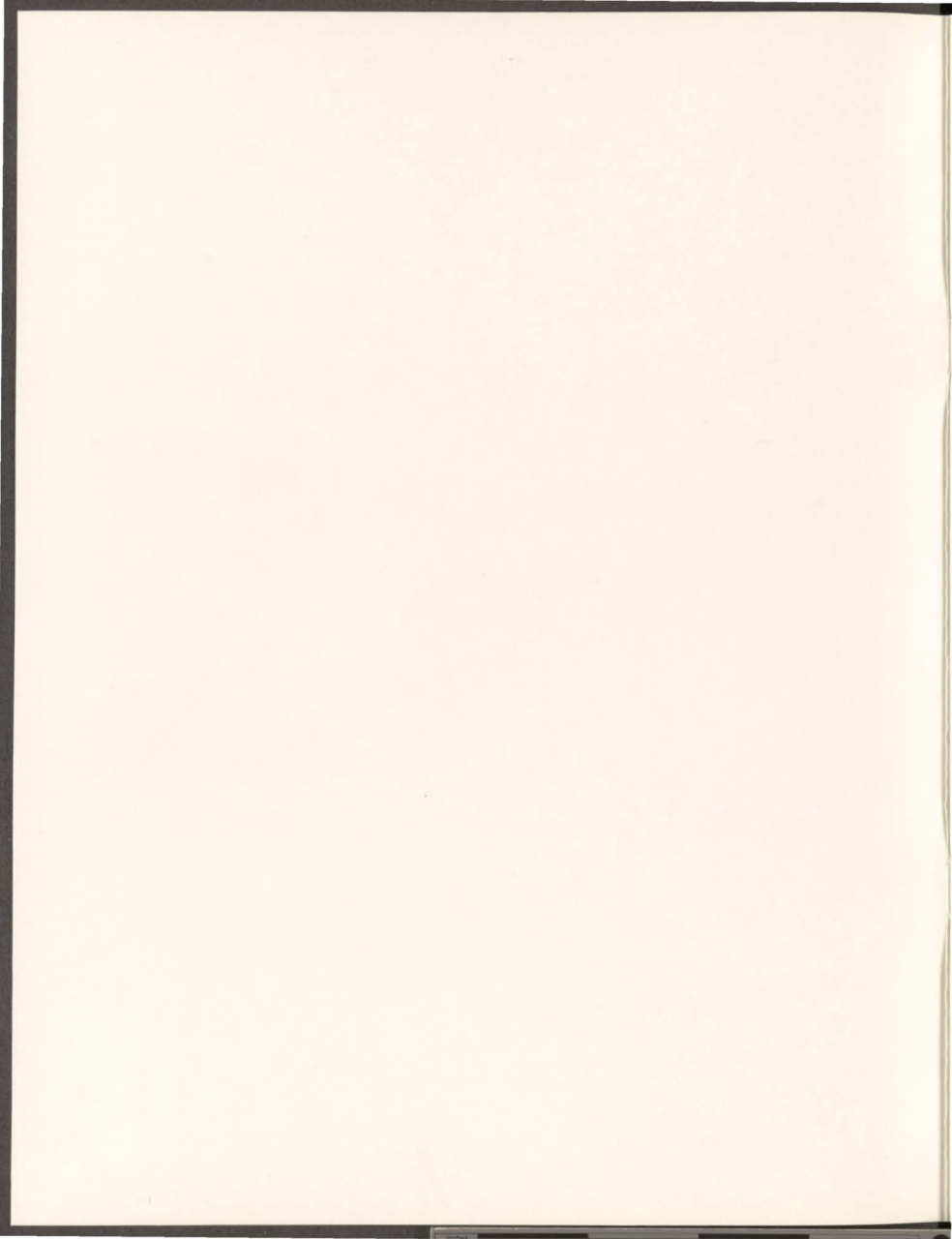

The University of Oregon opened its doors in 1876. Deady Hall housed the entire university in those days. Built of bricks made from clay dug out of the local hills, the building was guaranteed by its architect to last 1,000 years. The first commencement in 1878 graduated five students. Today the university serves 17,300 students on its 300-acre campus. More than 1,200 faculty members teach in its professional schools and its arts and sciences departments.

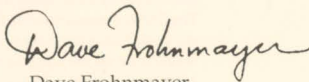
The university seal, shown on the front cover in the background and as the crown of the university mace, was created by Judge Matthew P. Deady, first president of the Board of Regents, and was approved by that body in 1878. In its center is a representation of Mt. Hood as a symbol of the state. Around its edge is the university's motto, *mens agitat molem*—mind moves the mass.

Graduating seniors who have earned at least 90 credits in residence at the University of Oregon and have completed all other university degree requirements shall be awarded graduation with honors: upper 2 percent, *summa cum laude*; upper 5 percent, *magna cum laude*; upper 10 percent, *cum laude*. These distinctions are based on students' percentile rankings for their graduation term. The honors determination for summer-session degree candidates is provisional. It is based on academic work completed prior to the term of graduation and is not official until final grades have been recorded.

Academic Costume

The history of academic dress goes back several centuries to the chilly universities where cap, gown, and hood were needed for covering and warmth. Subsequently this has become a ceremonial costume with certain standardized features. The hood is lined with the official colors of the degree-conferring institution; for the University of Oregon these are yellow and green. The outside trimming of the hood and the color of the tassel signify the subject in which the degree is conferred:

maize: agriculture
white: arts, letters, humanities
drab: commerce, accountancy, business
lilac: dentistry
copper: economics
light blue: education
orange: engineering
blue-violet: fine arts, architecture
russet: forestry
crimson: journalism
purple: law
lemon: library science
green: medicine
pink: music
apricot: nursing
silver gray: oratory, speech
olive green: pharmacy
dark blue: philosophy
sage green: physical education
peacock blue: public administration
salmon pink: public health
golden yellow: science
citron: social work
scarlet: theology
gray: veterinary science

At the University of Oregon it is customary for master's degree candidates to wear their hoods in the procession. Doctoral candidates carry their hoods and are hooded during the ceremony. Each bachelor's degree candidate changes the cap tassel from front right to front left as the degree is conferred. Caps are removed during the pledge song and during the commencement address.

University Mace

In medieval times the mace was usually carried into battle by kings, bishops, and other leaders for use as a weapon. Later on it came to be used more for ceremonial occasions. Today it is a symbol of authority.

The mace leading the University of Oregon's academic procession was designed and made by C. Max Nixon, professor emeritus of fine and applied arts, as a gift to the university. The creative use of copper, bronze, silver, and walnut typify the spirit of the university since its founding.

The head of the mace is a sphere made up of four university seals joined at a common axis. The outer rims of the seals are copper. The university's name and motto, in Latin, are in bronze. The mountain at the center of the sphere is in silver, while the forests and hills are in bronze. Surmounting the linked seals is a replica of Deady Hall, the university's first building, cast in bronze.

At the top of the oiled walnut shaft and within the sphere created by the seals is the university's founding date. At the base of the shaft is a finial ornament in bronze, finished with a stylized pine-cone pattern. Embedded in its tip is the seal of the State of Oregon, also in bronze.
