
REDUCED RAILROAD RATES

Reduced railroad rates of one and one third fares on the certificate plan, good over either the Southern Pacific or the Oregon Electric, have been granted the University of Oregon from May 30 to August 2. These rates are good for all of the University events coming between the two dates, including the annual Commencement exercises and the Summer School.

In order to secure reduced rates, *each person expecting to attend any of these events should secure a receipt or certificate from the ticket agent at the time of purchasing his railroad ticket to Eugene. If this certificate is not obtained, reduced rates cannot be granted.* This certificate properly signed by the Registrar of the University will entitle the holder to one third fare returning home.
