The strain of toil, the fret of care.

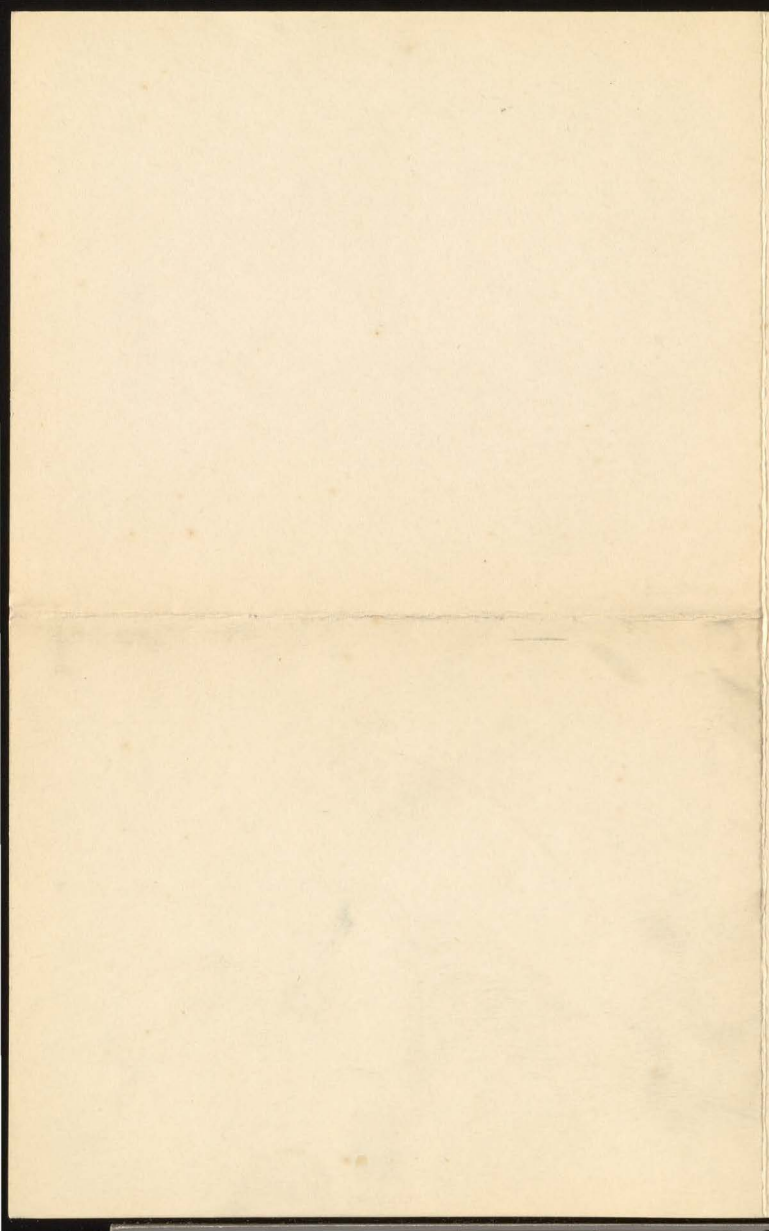
Help me the slow of heart to move
