Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Wednesday, April 04, 2012

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

***NOTE:** The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. NO LUBA Notification to the jurisdiction of an appeal by the deadline, this Plan Amendment is acknowledged.

ORDINANCE NO. 584

AN ORDINANCE REDESIGNATING VARIOUS PARCELS OF PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL TO MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ON THE SCIO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission periodically reviews land use regulations of the City Planning Commission to ensure the City complies with Statewide Land Use Planning Goals and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Scio Planning Commission has initiated a land use application (City File 2011-04) to redesignate sixteen parcels comprising 4.60 acres of land on the Scio Comprehensive Plan Map from Residential to Multi-Family Residential; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on February 15, 2012 to consider the application and upon deliberation, after the close of the public hearing, recommended the city council approve the application; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on March 12, 2012 and at the close of the hearing the City Council concurred with the Planning Commission recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted findings of fact approving the land use application;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Scio hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: SCIO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP AMENDMENTS. The Scio Comprehensive Plan Map shall be amended to redesignate certain properties within the City of Scio. Attached hereto is Exhibit "A", which is a map which accurately portrays the properties to be redesignated and Exhibit "B" which lists the properties to be redesignated on the Comprehensive Plan Map.

SECTION 2: RECORD. The City Recorder shall submit to the Linn County GIS office and Linn County Clerk a certified true copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If a section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

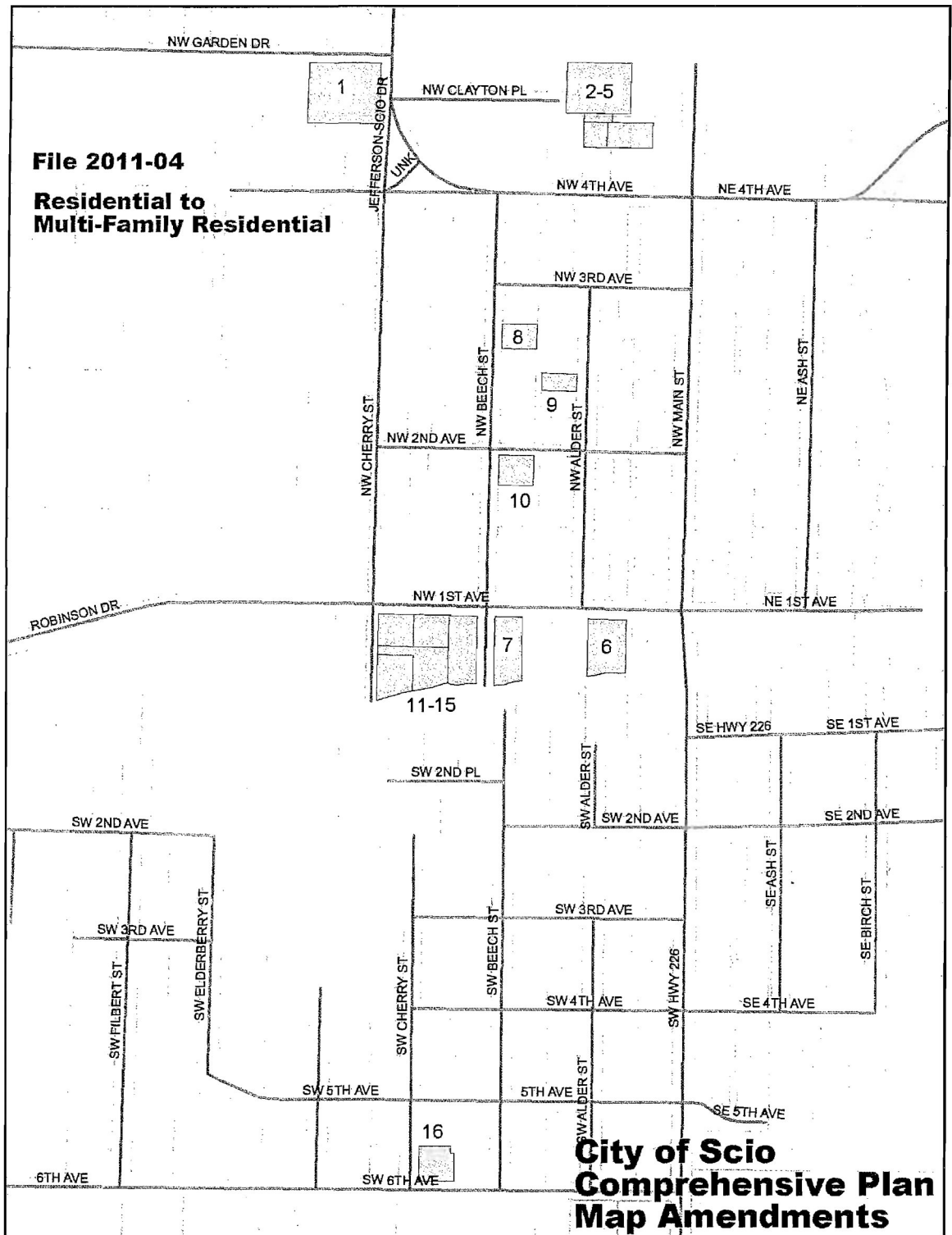
