REDUCED RAILROAD RATES.

Reduced railroad rates of one and one-third fares, on the certificate plan, have been granted the University of Oregon from June 14th to August 4th. These rates are good for all of the University events coming between the two dates, including the annual Commencement exercises (June 16th to 19th), Summer School (June 24th to August 2d), the conventions of the Oregon Congress of Mothers and Parent-Teachers' Association (July 2d to 3d), Librarians' Convention (dates to be announced), and Town and Country Life Conferences (dates to be announced), etc. In order to secure the reduced rates, *each person expecting to attend any of these events should secure a receipt or certificate from the ticket agent at the time of purchasing his railroad ticket to Eugene. If this certificate is not obtained, reduced rates can not be granted.* This certificate properly signed by the Registrar of the University will entitle the holder to one-third fare returning home.
