If no choice is indicated, the Extension Division will give careful attention to the selection of a speaker from those available for the date indicated.

There is no designated fee for commencement addresses, as is the case in some states, but high schools are expected to pay all traveling expenses. The speaker is not released from any of his work at the University but takes on the commencement addresses in addition to his regular duties.

It is frequently possible for a group of neighboring high schools at a distance from the University to arrange their commencement programs on sequential days so as to use the same speaker, and thus reduce the expenses.
