Arrangements are being made with the United States Railroad Administration to obtain reduced rates of one and one-third fares on the certificate plan over all lines, for those attending commencement exercises and the summer school, good between the dates June 9 and August 4, 1919. It is hoped and expected that the University will be able to obtain these rates for its summer school students and for those attending commencement exercises.

In order to obtain the benefit of this reduced rate, should the University be successful, each person expecting to attend any of the events between the dates mentioned should *secure a receipt or certificate from the ticket agent at the time of purchasing his railroad ticket to Eugene.* If this certificate is not obtained, reduced rates cannot be secured under any circumstances. The certificate must be signed by the registrar of the University before the return ticket can be purchased at the reduced rate.
