- Paved walking & bike paths
- Seating areas & river overlooks

Ruth Bascom Willamette Riverbank

Trail End Points: N Delta Rd. (Eugene) and Island Park, 200 West B St. (Springfield)

- 19 ADA parking spaces at east end
- Paved & smooth 8-ft wide trail
- 7.7-mile loop

Willamette River: South Bank-North Bank

Location: 200 Day Island Rd, Eugene, OR 97402

- 2.3-mile loop trail
- Paved, smooth asphalt with 6-ft wide trails
- Gentle 3% grade or less
