Congratulations to you and your families and friends on the eve of your graduation. We invite all of you to join us for Commencement—a day of celebration that binds our community together.

The all-university ceremony for degree candidates will be held June 13 at Hayward Field—McArthur Court in case of rain. Each of the colleges and schools will host ceremonies to honor their individual graduates. Most of these ceremonies are on the same day as the main ceremony. Please refer to the table for specific dates, times, and locations.

The following information will help you and your guests prepare for Commencement. Please share this with them.



General Information

DISABILITY SERVICES

Seating for guests with special mobility needs will be available.

At the main ceremony, limited wheelchair seating on the west side of Hayward Field, Section D, is accessible from E. 15th Avenue via Gate 1. A sign-language interpreter will also be present. We recommend that guests with impaired hearing sit in the first few rows of the west side of the field closest to the platform.

TICKETS

Tickets are not required for any ceremony, unless the main ceremony moves to Mac Court in the event of rain.

DIPLOMAS

Although degrees are conferred at Commencement, please remember that diplomas are not handed out at the time of the ceremony. Diplomas are mailed to degree recipients ten to twelve weeks after graduation to the address given on the Application for Degree form. All work necessary for the degree must be on file in the Office of the Registrar on or before June 22, 1998, to receive a spring degree.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Degree candidates are encouraged to wear regalia (gown, cap, tassel, and hoods for doctoral and master's degree candidates). Regalia, including honor cords for those graduating with honors, and announcements are available at the Information Center, main floor, UO Bookstore, (541) 346-4331. The deadline to place a rental order is Wednesday, May 20. Bachelor candidates may purchase their regalia until June 13.

The following are prices are for rental and purchase and include payment for a diploma cover:

- Doctoral candidates \$55 (rental fee)
- Master's candidates \$47 (rental fee)
- Bachelor's candidates \$32.50 (purchase price)

For your convenience, the bookstore will be open Saturday, June 13 from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. and Sunday, June 14 from noon to 6:00 P.M.

DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

On Commencement Day, information booths will be located at East 18th Avenue and University Street, East 15th Avenue and Agate Street, East 15th Avenue and University Street, and East 13th Avenue and Agate Street.

For your guests' convenience, tour maps of the UO campus will be available at the information desk on the first floor of Oregon Hall, until 5:00 P.M. Friday, June 12, 1998. On Saturday, please ask for maps at the Erb Memorial Union Main Desk, (541) 346-4362, or at the information booths.

Parking on campus during Commencement will be tight. Please direct your guests to the lots closest to your individual ceremony.

SPECIAL NOTES

It is usually breezy and can be chilly at Hayward Field this time of year, so advise your guests to dress prepared for the weather.

Please remember that alcoholic beverages detract from the dignity of the ceremony and are not allowed in Hayward Field.

All-University Commencement Ceremony

The main ceremony will be held at 12:30 p.m. Saturday, June 13, at Hayward Field, (McArthur Court in case of rain). It will end at 2:30 p.m.

In case of rain, all other ceremonies will be held indoors (see table), and the switch to rain locations will be announced on local radio and TV stations beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday.

You may attend and participate in the ceremony whether or not you are graduating. However, if you have not filed for a degree or are not actually graduating, your name will not appear in the program. Members of the Order of the Emerald (students who graduated more than fifty years ago) will also participate in the ceremony.

ASSEMBLY

Candidates should assemble on the practice field at East 18th Avenue and Agate Street no later than noon. The practice field can be entered from 18th Avenue and the south end of Hayward Field. Graduates should assemble by college or school and, for the College of Arts and Sciences, by departments.

Doctoral candidates. Cards with your name and your adviser's name will be handed out in the assembly area. Please make certain you have a card before the processional begins.

PROCESSIONAL

Faculty marshals and banner and sign carriers will assemble and lead each group of candidates to their appropriate section. Please remain standing until President Dave Frohnmayer asks you to be seated.

CONFERRAL OF DEGREES

Doctoral Candidates. Please stand when asked by Dean Steadman Upham, and remain standing during the conferral of degrees. When you are asked, come forward to be

formally hooded, then hand your name card to the reader. Cross the platform to receive greetings from President Frohnmayer and your diploma cover from Provost John Moseley. Return to your seat, and sit immediately.

Master's Candidates. Please stand when asked by Dean Upham, and remain standing during the conferral of degrees. Following the conferral, you will be asked to sit. Individual recognition will be given at the individual college and school ceremonies.

Bachelor's Candidates. Please stand when asked by the dean of your school or college, and remain standing until all candidates have been called upon and the degrees conferred. Once the degree has been conferred, move your tassel from right to left. Individual recognition will be given at the college and school ceremonies.

RECESSIONAL

The recessional marks the conclusion of the main ceremony. President Frohnmayer will ask the graduates to recess to individual ceremonies following the main ceremony. The deans, marshals, and standard bearers will lead you.



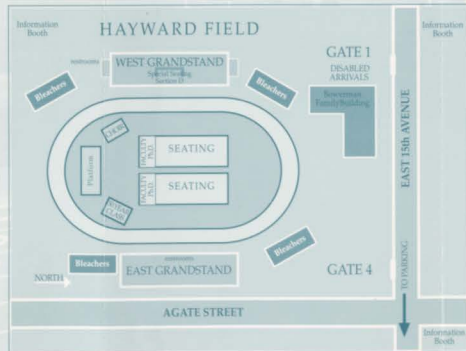
