The University

The University of Oregon opened its doors to 177 students on October 16, 1876. Today the University enrolls some 17,000 students. Its 925 faculty are engaged in teaching, research, and scholarship covering a broad range of humanistic, scientific, and professional knowledge.

The campus houses 35 departments and special programs in the liberal arts; nine professional schools and colleges; 12 research bureaus, institutes, and centers; and a graduate division.

The University's more than 80,000 alumni include two graduates who have won the Nobel Prize: William Parry Murphy, co-winner of the prize in 1934 for a development in the treatment of anemia, and Walter Houser Brattain, who won it in 1956 for the co-invention of the transistor. Seventeen Rhodes Scholars call the U of O their alma mater.

The University is one of only 24 public schools in the nation to be selected for membership in the prestigious American Association of Universities.

Commencement Setting: Memorial Quadrangle

Today's Commencement setting is the Memorial Quadrangle facing the University of Oregon Library. The Library was founded in 1882 with a gift from Henry Villard. The two rows of Pyramidal English Oaks which line the Quadrangle were a gift to the University in memory of Robert Chase Bailey who was president of the senior class in 1939. A bronze plaque on the library patio wall behind the speaker's platform also honors the memory of Bailey. A verse on the plaque written by Professor Emeritus Robert D. Horn reads :

Here where the living mind and step of youth retrace
The ancient path to human wisdom's goal,
The symmetry of oaks shall keep this place
For one, for all who like him seek the whole
Joy of life for men, in thought, in soul,
In body, voice, and friendship's smiling face.

"The ancient path to human wisdom's goal" is further exemplified by the Library facade. Above the entrances are reminders of the purpose of education : "Ye Shall Know the Truth," over the east doorway, "And the Truth Shall Make You Free," (John 8:32) over the west doorway.

Below the cornice of the Library is a series of sculptured heads representing the seven major liberal arts disciplines : *Philosophia*, *Historia*, *Religio*, *Ars*, *Natura*, *Societas* and *Litterae*. The individuals represented are : Aquinas, Aristotle, Locke, Thucydides, Buddha, Christ, Michelangelo, Beethoven, DaVinci, Newton, Darwin, Jefferson, Holmes, Shakespeare, and Dante.

Under the cornice of the Museum of Art, the building on the east side of the Quadrangle, is a series of recurring sculptured heads each representing one form of art : Primitive, Egyptian, Greek, and Oriental. On the front steps of the Museum is the sculpture, "Indian Maiden and Fawn," one of four sculptures on the campus executed by Alexander Phimster Proctor.

To the west of Memorial Quadrangle is Prince Lucien Campbell Hall named in honor of the University's fourth president. In its courtyard is a sculpture, "The Falconer," by James Lee Hansen. This sculpture was donated by Jordan Schnitzer, Class of 1974, to honor three University of Oregon English professors.

The walks on the Quadrangle were the gift of Colonel William S. Gilbert, U.S. Army Chaplain, who served in the Philippines and through World War I. The walks are dedicated as a memorial to the men of the University who served their country in time of war. The Rev. Mr. Gilbert was a member of the University's Board of Regents from about 1920 to 1932.

Modern art is represented on the Quadrangle by Duane Lopnow's yellow metal sculpture, "Reflections on a Summer Day," a fitting title for this occasion.

The University of Oregon's Centennial



"EDUCATION: A Heritage and Future for Oregon" is the theme of the University of Oregon's year-long Centennial observance which began January 1, 1976.

In August of 1872, five Eugene citizens resolved to build a University. They organized the Union University Association and presented a proposal to the 1872 State Legislature that the State locate the University of Oregon in Eugene if the local citizens could buy a site and erect on it a building worth \$50,000. Governor LaFayette Grover signed the enabling act "To create, organize and locate the University of the State of Oregon . . ." on October 19, 1872. Deady Hall, located on a 17 acre site, opened its doors on October 16, 1876 to 177 students, 79 in the collegiate course and 98 in the preparatory program, with a faculty of five.

The University's first class graduated in 1878 with five students eligible for degrees. The community celebrated the event. Newspaper accounts reported that people donated art works to hang on the walls of the auditorium and hundreds attended to honor the first graduates.

Today the University of Oregon enrolls more than 17,000 students and confers more than 3,500 bachelor, master and doctoral degrees each year. The campus encompasses some 250 acres with 41 major buildings. The full-time faculty numbers 925.

The basic mission of the University has remained what the 1872 Legislature authorized: "The University shall have for its design to provide instruction and complete education in all departments of science, literature, professional pursuits and general education. . . ."

Academic Costume

The history of academic dress goes back several centuries, to the chilly universities where cap and gown and hood were needed for covering and warmth. Subsequently this has become a ceremonial costume, with certain standardized features. For example, sleeves in the bachelor's gown are pointed, in the master's gown are oblong, in the doctor's gown are bell-shaped. Only the doctor's gown has velvet facing. The hood is lined with the official colors of the degree-conferring institution; for the University of Oregon these are lemon yellow and green. The outside trimming of the hood and the color of the tassel signify the subject in which the degree is conferred, as follows:

At the University of Oregon it is customary for master's candidates to wear their hoods in the academic procession. Doctoral candidates carry their hoods and are hooded during the ceremony. Traditionally, baccalaureate candidates change tassels on their caps from front right to the front left as the degree is conferred.

Caps are removed during prayer, the playing of the National Anthem and the Alma Mater, and during the commencement address if desired.
