Hyundai Survey - Friends of Eugene Sample Report

(Interviewing August 11-14, 1995)

SAMPLING METHODOLOGY

The sample was generated by a list-assisted Waksberg random-digit-dialing protocol developed by Genesys Sampling Systems, Inc. Researchers selected the Eugene area by zip code (selecting zip codes 97401 to 97405), and the Genesys system selected out telephone prefixes of that area. Inexact mapping of telephone prefixes to geography required that a qualifying question be asked of respondents. That question asked "Do you live within the Eugene city limits?" Respondents who answered no were not interviewed for the survey; all others were considered to be in the population of interest.
