All are very important to institutional repositories!

Questions to think about

- What type of content is it?
- How will the content be used?
- Is order important?
- Are relationships between titles important?
- How much control do you really have?

Points to remember

- Issues & choices tied to IR software
- Impacted by earlier decisions about overall IR organization, content & workflow
- Not a decision flowchart – many things must be considered at the same time
- ***There is no one correct answer!***

 - At the collection level?
 - At the item level?
- Addition of contextual information

- Order of content in title browse display
- Closely related to construction of title in item metadata records
- Will each *issue* be one IR item?
- Will each *article* be one IR item?
- Is order important? Page number as published? Alphabetical by article title?

Construction of *item title*

- Important for title recognition
- Again, is order important?
- Is transcription important? In which fields? Serial title? Serial numbering? Page numbers? Article titles?

- Impact of title changes and variations
- Numbering as part of title
- Page numbers as part of title
- Other additions to the title

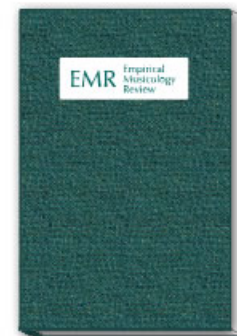


