**Why (do you say that)?**

A few roads around my house that do not get fixed and the pass to Jacksonville never gets built

A lot of area that need to be prepare and that they don't do.

A lot of roads (heavily traveled roads nothing done, less traveled roads are really kept up. Fixing residential roads not heavy traveled roads. Waste of tax money. Working against the taxpayers. Priorities not right. Too much money spent up on Sylvan off of Highway 26 (exit off it). 43 million spent on redoing intersection. Loused up further. Biggest bungled up job, can't believe we spend that kind of money and have that kind of a mess. Bunch of men doing something they don't know what they are doing, adding another light! And a few expletives.

An awful lot of roads out in the rural areas that are not kept up

Because all the roads are steel plates on them. no tires. because of the snow tires the roads are in bad shape. not a smooth ride.

Because I don't travel those kinds of roadways, I'm pretty local in a small community (p) it's the traffic problem that I don't like (p) I don't know, it's hard to say, there's always room for improvement I guess

Because I know they can do better

Because I know through my community they put in a lot of lights going through the highway and did not change the speed limit, and people are still going 55 and you can't stop in time for the light.

Because I run into a lot of potholes on the side roads. (p) I live out here on two-twelve and they just put in sidewalks a couple of years ago then they tore them up and put down new sidewalks. I see no need for why they had to redo it.

Because I think I am paying a lot to maintain the roads and there tends to be construction at bad hours of the day. The roads have pot holes.

Because I think the highways are rutted up and the bridges look like they're in poor shape and they're old and they're crowded. (p) You can sit on the Sellwood bridge for a million years, and the same with the two-oh-five bridge through Oregon City.

Because I think they are spending too much time doing repairs

Because I think. I'll give you an example as soon as a road is all smoothed out and re-paved someone else comes along and digs it up again. Why can't they do all these things at the same time.

Because I've run across different roads in Washington county that are in desperate need of repair, and there are holes in the road that can break an axle, and they don't repair them, year after year (p) that's the main one, there's different roads, not just one or two, they go down the main highway and repair the roads there, but they don't cover any of the side streets that are traveled

Because it is not very often that the city transportation during highways. like busses more kinds.

Because it just seems like a slow process you see them working but it takes a long time.

Because it seems they patch the roads over and over again there are other states that do it more efficiently than we do

Because I've lived in Cal and other states, Washington...they maintain their roads excellent.

Because of the condition of highway 334 it's a mess, especially the stretch from Waldport to Philomath and from Sweet Home to the top of the Santa and highway 20

Because some main roads I drive are in poor condition. These are main thoroughfares.

Because that .lots of roads that need repairing

Because the lack of funds available to them to make the repairs.

Because there are a lot of pot holes on my street

Because they are not doing anything the roads and they are bringing in the stupid light rail. That isn't going to help people. I wish they would get rid of it.

Because they are not planning ahead for the traffic, I mean if you have to go from one area to another it takes forever. It's ridiculous how slow you have to go because there are more cars on the road than they are accounting for. With all of the construction, it just takes forever and it's really annoying.

Because they are ripping up the roads all the time and never finishing.

Because they could be better.

Because they don't have the money because of Sizemore.

Because they need to expand Sunnyside road they've been promising for ten years, in Clackamas.

Because they pick the weirdest time to fix the highways and they're always hazardous because people are using the highways frequently and as a result it's very difficult to keep from having an accident with the way people drive. I mean I know they're trying to maintain them, but it seems that they're doing it during peak times of the day.

Because they seem to be constantly repairing instead of doing the job right the first time.

Because they waste so much money. multi million dollars. They changed Mount Hood meadow and not fixed a high way, took a long time.

Because we have some of the worst roads in the nation. here in Albany the are take along time with repairs. Elm street for example. they don't have thee money or the manpower.

But I must mention the enormous problems with whether that was not foreseeable. The mudslides, the huge expenditures that represent. They need to tax us more for good roads. The tax should be more fairly allocated. If you have a heavily newer car you pay more taxes. I am very suspicious of the huge trucks. I think they are damaging the roads but if we must have 80 kinds of cheerios then we must have the trucks. I remember when we had trains. If we went den to 18 kinds of cereals into 800 it might be easier on the roads. but how to we fix that? the only strategy that government has is taxation.

Cause they're not spending enough money fixing the highways and bridges. I guess they don't have the money.

Cause where I'm living there are some roads that really need fixing and we don't have the money for that (p)the county or the state, we have certain roads that are heavily traveled, but they are not getting fixed, there are too many potholes

Fair in regard I'm been on lot of road s that are awful and road configuration that actually don't ease congestion

For what they have to work with they are doing the best they can

Half our bridges need to be replaced and all they worry is the max line.

Here is the scoop. The county will repay the same road over and over. where the state comes to the county line that is where they end. Since 1973 the road in front of Elmira has not been fixed. I just saw Lane County ODOT do shoulder maintenance and they didn't do a very good job. I pay taxes for this and they could have done a better job with just my taxes. They over maintain some roads and they don't fix other stuff that need to be fixed. highway 99 near Goshen, Creswell and Cottage Grove has never been re-paved. But on 7th street down town they will repave when it is not needed. They need to reprioritize.

Highway 47 is terrible and they have done nothing about it.

Highway 99 is hideous

I am a contractor. I know how they should be kept. Well, the bridges are kept pretty good. The roads are lacking in a lot of areas.

I can't remember the last time I could drive through Salem and not have the freeway under construction as well as hwy 20 to the coast.

I don't believe they're keeping things up to where they should be

I don't think some other states put more money into roads very little is provided in the safety element roads are marked very bad more markings should be on abutments

I don't drive anymore. A lot of the local roads don't get taken care of. Potholes and things like that.

I don't drive much

I drive highway 58 it's poor

I drive sunset and 217 and they are awful. They are so congested you can't drive them.

I guess to me the grooves in the freeway are getting warn pretty bad and the water stands in the grooves.

I just hear on local TV or radio, NPR. the State of far away, not good roads or highways. I think they do a good job, but problems of not enough money.

I just the pothole thing

I just think that they need to start, I don't agree with the philosophy of pushing mass transit when the freeways are clogged and not try adding more lanes to the freeway

I know there's a lot of bridge work needs to be done, they could more money into it (p) the highways I think they are doing what they can, but I know bridges have been falling behind I think for years. not so much as replacing it, but maintaining what we got, sometimes it comes to replacing them, I know that

I live in a rural area. They are slow repairing; when they come to repair they are slow and we have to repair it ourselves. The maintenance isn't too bad, but they often do it cheaply, like using a grater to fill asphalt, and it is not designed for that.

I'm not sure .I think they don't have enough money. there is a huge influx of population. it may not be fair of me to say they are doing a bad job, they are doing a fair job with what they have.

I say fair because I live in Yamhill County. And there are a lot of potholes and the bridge to Salem (the St. Paul Hwy) has been under construction and reconstruction for a long time and it's a lot of hassle to go to Salem, and I guess

it's the amount of time that it actually takes to do their repairs that annoys me. (p) I think that they close roads at inappropriate commuter times and that really bothers me

I say that where we live. We have covered bridges, one time a board was knocked out by a logging truck. I saw 5 people take 2 hours to fix it. I think we could do better than that. Fix it more efficiently. We have a lot of pothole here in the country and it takes them quite a bit of time to fix them.

I see a lot of traffic problems. I don't think they have a very good engineer.

I see a lot of work done on a lot of spots that don't need work over and over and other spots in need of repair where nothing is done.

I seen the California highways and Oregon's are better. They used to be better when I first came here but they are 100 percent than Californian roads. But they could be better.

I think that their priorities need to be more towards the roads that people travel on, not enough traffic control and too many potholes and the highways are too crowded, like Hwy 217 and Hwy 265 need to be expanded

I think that we need a lot of road repair. I know we don't have a lot of state money to do that with but I think that if we could maybe charge the people who are using our roads interstate more, I think the big trucks are tearing our roads up.

I think there are a lot of highways that are not kept up. Too many new roads into the forest that's bad

I think there are a lot of roads that need repair. London road near Cottage Grove. I-5 all up and down I-5. We need better planning, there is too much traffic.

I think there are a lot of roads that need upgrading and maintaining and other alternative forms of transportation need to be looked. I feel that they are constrained financially

I think there is money that we have been taxed out of money and ODOT is not spending the money where the money is allocated to go

I think there's a lot of places that need improvement, but they are doing a good job in some places

I think there's a misallocation of resources

I think they are going after the mass transit .a few people ride something, potholes undone. Lots of guys working out there wasting money private companies would be more efficient.

I think thy have done some repair work they had to do over . It was shoddy.

I used to work for the Department of Engineering. I know the amount of work they get done.

I work for a petroleum company and we get screwed all the time.

It depends on how much money they have because they are not doing good job. The studs are causing ruts. and channels and when they get full water you hydro plane like mad. Cross county I know Oregon roads are better than most.

It takes a long time to do some things

It's poor mostly because of budget problems

Its needs to be managed better

I've been on many, many roads in Oregon that are in desperate need of being fixed. And they will repave something that doesn't even need it, and neglect the others. (p) One in particular was Hyacinth, it's just a road or a street, I don't know.

Just because I have lived in rural areas with state roads that are not taken well care and the bridges, after flooding did not appear safe.

Just because of things I hear, like I said I'm blind, I heard that there were several bridges that were actually crumbling and it makes me really nervous to think that could happen,

Just by looking at conditions of the roads

Just from the roads are quite often and disrepair and being worked on. I don't see the reasons for the roads to be see so bad with the mild weather you have hear.

Just I know some roads in areas in the rural areas of the state that are in disrepair

Just not that great .hard to go downtown, too much traffic.

Just the roads need more repairing, all in the state. (P) all when I drove by, lots of holes.

Just the traffic. it has grown so much worse tin the last ten years . It used to take me 20 min. to get down town now it takes 45 min. from Sherwood to Portland center.

Look at our roads and how much we pay in taxes

Look at what they've done and what they haven't done

Lots of roads in bad shape

Most Hi ways are OK, but a lot of construction and we travel quite a bit. we live on Highway 26 and it's real good now.

Not really satisfied with the condition of the roads. I recognize their budget limitations, but I am not satisfied with the roads especially in the rural areas.

Oh well this is a rainy state we get chuckholes

On their projects they don't proceed as fast as they should. they seem to really draw it out whenever they do anything

Poor shape of roads and a reputation of bad work force

Pot holes and road repair. I'm not sure which roads fall under state jurisdiction.

Pretty fair job

Roads are pretty good

Rutted roads.

See lots of pot holes in our area

Some of the repairs are too temporary. they put up a sign instead of repairing the road

Some of the roads really need more repair. (p) there's so many, the ones that come to my mind are Highway Fifty-eight going from Eugene to Oakridge, Highway Twenty from Corvallis to Newport, and Highway Eighteen going from Portland to Lincoln City, those are just a few. (p) Yes, I-5 going into Portland coming from South, I would say probably from Woodburn on.

Some roads are rough. Some paved roads went to gravel. Also I have waited 45 minutes at the DMV, they passed me over for someone else.

Sometimes I think it could be better.

Sometimes there is a lot of problems when they repair the roads.

Streets and roads need repair and they always give it to the most traveled instead of the ones that really need to be fixed

Take a look at your roads versus what they have been in the past they were taken care of a lot better in the past.

The bridges are falling apart on the highway down to the coast. (P) Highway 101 on the coast

The community that we live in, the roads are in very poor shape. Potholes and lack of funds brush along the road.

The fact I live on strip that has 10-15 accidents a month due to a lack of posting signs. Off northwest express way towards Junction City

The highways aren't marked clearly with center lines and fog lines along the side. On a rainy night it's hard to see. (p) Well, they expect us to keep our cars in good condition, I think the highways should be kept in good condition too.

The manner in which they organize the road repairs is poorly managed. they have various massive undertakings at once along my route. and they conduct these during business hours. I think they should do the repairs one spot at a time. I have seen it better managed in other states and cities.

The ODOT was stopping traffic between here and Jacksonville asking where you came from, where you are going, and why? I didn't like and I want to know why they did that because I don't think they need to know.

The road washouts in our area and they won't fix it. There's 32 feet of blacktop at the Douglas county Coos line and they won't fix the problem. They say they don't have enough money to fix it. They keep telling the residents when Tillamook went out, but we have the slides here too. They only fix Tillamook.

The roads are becoming northern. I-205 going to close down

The roads are terrible. I know that with the number of cars the gas tax should cover it.

The roads need some work, it seems to me 4 to 6 months goes by before they fix something, like a pothole, they fix the pothole once a year. I would like them to fix it right once

The roads take too long too be repaired.

The way they just patch them up within a year they are breaking up again.

There are a lot of eroded areas that never get fixed properly

There are lots of things that could be done we have a lot of state roads need to be repaired. we don't have enough money. The county roads are in better shape. the highway in McMinnville where all the people died.

There are too many roads that need to be repaired. they concentrate on the big stuff not on the smaller areas

There are. some needed to be fixed .when you go by there, you can see one work and the others just stand there.

There is a lot of construction going on. It is inconvenience mostly

There is an awful lot to be done, more roads to be built and the population s increasing, road remain the same , Portland to Newport

There's a lot of messed up roads, a lot of the highways around here are pretty rutted [P: any in particular?] oh, I don't know

There's a lot of potholes

There's a lot of roads that need a lot of work.

There's been so many deaths and accidents between Hermiston and Pendleton. They had not budgeted to maintain that stretch of highway.

There's just a ;lot of potholes

There's some things that I see that I don't like about some of the roads, [I repeated her answer] the highways, yeah

There's too much traffic on the roads. Nothing is being done. They keep building more and more but nothing is being done about the traffic.

They are continually doing something traffic is bad enough without all that stuff going on

They could do a better job, there is a bridge that has too much traffic, they need another bridge [where is that] ferry street.

They do alright with the money they have, but we have a lot potholes.

They fix the street and they go to the other side they start on one street and don't finish it. Too much time and too much money.

They have a pothole around. I hit one the other day

They just do much as they could with the resources they have.

They keep saying they are not getting any revenue and they keep getting tax increases. More people driving and paying taxes and where is the money going. Environmentalists impact the work the highway workers can do because environmental statements keep workers fearful of even cleaning a ditch because of hurting the environment.

They let a bridge go- they could have saved it. In Eastern Oregon by the John Day

They ruined one person business by blocking off an access that was absolutely disgusting. He should be compensated.

They take to long doing their job

They used to do a better job a few years back

Too many roads not getting repaired

Travel the roads they are not too good in shape

Travelling back and forth, my experiences are just fair.

Um, when I am traveling on different highways, there are uneven spots, potholes that could be dangerous.

Umm...I would just say they need to do a little more to make them roadworthy.

Unfashionable, do such a poor job, the highways are not good .they are not good.

We live in central Oregon and the roads are bad...two lanes...should have passing lanes.

We moved from Pennsylvania. The roads are much better there. The way people use studded tires here and such, the roads are damaged and not repaired often.

We need a lot of work and we have congestion on I5 particularly

Well (laughter) the street that I live on, they have ripped up and haven't done anything to finish the paving. They did the first layer of paving and no one has even seen anyone in three weeks to finish it, the equipment is still here, but no men are here. (p) It's the northeast corner of Clackamas County. (p: Is that something that ODOT is working on?) I don't know. I know that Highway two-oh-five, the ruts in the center lane are so deep that a small sports car cannot maintain proper control.

Well based on the streets and that type of thing streets need to be thought out better particularly off ramps

Well because some of they roads are excellent some horrible

Well I can live out in the rural area. some are not well kept up. I have seen progress that is why I say fair

Well I don't think that all of the roads are great, but they're doing what they can.

Well I just keep hearing that we need a lot of bridges fixed and they're always talking about the trucks wearing the roads out, that sort of thing. They sometimes don't get the lines painted. Sometimes they don't get the holes fixed after the winter. Bumpy roads...maintenance is not that wonderful sometimes.

Well I often see bridges and roadways I think need to be repaired. The potholes in the rural areas are bad. When I look under the bridges, I see they need to be repaired and there is a fair amount of erosion underneath.

Well I think they don't have much money to handle the roads with they do best they can

Well I think we should have more of a mass transit structure instead of building new roads and trying to maintain them.

Well if you don't have the money you can't do the repairs

Well it's taken them a long time to fix highway 20 between Lebanon and Albany

Well I've seen a lot of places that need help. People are unhappy with how the chuck holes.

Well lots of pot holes. they don't fix them anymore. that's it pretty much. I don't know if they don't have the money or what.

Well the are worse now than they used to be

Well the I-5 going south. People are going to retire off that before they get it straightened out.

Well the roads that I deal with around here are not in very good shape. (p) Specifically I drive Highway two-oh-five a lot and it's very rutted. (p) Let see nearest one is Johnson Creek Boulevard.

Well there is a lot of work to be done. They may not have all the money. The streets need a lot of work when you have a lot of cars on the road.

Well there's a lot of road that need to be built, and they need somebody to do it. (p) They're doing fair-to-good.

Well what bother s me is they do a lot of roads that don't really need to be done and don't do roads that do need to be done

Well, because all they concentrate on is Portland and I-5 they don't concentrate on the secondary roads, you ought to see this road between here and Lyons (p) it's Hwy 226 it's just a patchwork it's falling apart (P) I see them send out 5 trucks and 15 people to put one guardrail up

Well, because in the community where I live the main road, which is also a state highway, is generally very much in need of repair. (p) Oh there's a lot of cold patches, pot holes where they fill them with cold patches. Also I don't feel they're using their budget efficiently to build new roads and highways; there's a drastic need for that and they've misplaced a half a billion dollars in construction funds in the last biennium. That disturbs me greatly, I wonder how long that's been going on.

Well, because we live. there is a state bridge going over a piece of our property. They go to paint it and they take forever to do it and they paint the middle of it on the inside only. They paint the stripes on the road when it is freezing and when the ice disappears so do the stripes. They do patchwork and they don't fix it. If they would go ahead and build a good road base in the first place it would last a lot longer. They do a lot of busy work but don't do a lot of real sound work. It's a waste of tax dollars.

Well, cause there is so many roads and so many needed repairs.

Well, from travelling around the country comparing the different highways to state of Oregon ours are in pretty good shape to the rest. There could be a lot less politics. So, spend more money on the roads. I think it could be put to better use on the roads instead of in management and upper areas.

Well, have you driven down the road lately? <P> Oh, I drive between Newburg and Lake Oswego every day, and it's terrible. <P> Stafford Road has huge potholes. And Highway 99. And none of the freeways are a picnic.

Well, the conditions of the road here and there

Well, there's a lot of streets and highways and some that could use betterment, I think there's too much money spend needlessly on a lot of foolish things, in my town. in my city, they closed one street between 2 other main streets leading to the hospital. you can only go one way. there must be someone that has an "in" with the city council. I feel that is wrong. money talks you know.

Well, we are driving between Medford and Ashland it is not all smooth driving

Well, you know, there are too many roads in bad repair.

Well. the roads and bridges in our area are in dire need of repair.

Well. there is the road where I live are horrible. pod holes everywhere. It is Johnolson Rd. in Beaverton.

When I drive the roads and bridges need repair

**Why (do you say that)?**

Because a lot of highways are poorly lit from Eugene to Medford.

Because compared with other states I've been in Oregon roads they are ok but not the best. when I go out on the road they have one guy working and six guys watching their efficiency stinks. if it was run by a private company doing roads all the guys would be fired

Because I am probably not well informed, in order to answer it. I do not know how they do; how much money they get; I honestly don't know. How good a job are taxpayers doing with providing money? It's complicated.

Because I don't think that they are being realistic about the geology of the coastline there is more of an emphasis on economics of tourism and taxpayers ultimately for huge repair jobs which wont last very long. I have a scientific background and have seen the slides and don't think they are taking geologic and land use reasoning into consideration as much as engineering and development.

Because I don't think they're keeping up with the population as far as providing adequate roadways, freeways. (p) I drive the metro area a lot between Wilsonville and Portland, we're talking more about the two-oh-five rather than the five.

Because I drive a lot on the roads and I don't think they are maintained very well (p) no

Because I drive everyday and the grooves, the potholes, the unpaved streets, I live on a street that has no drainage, I have no curbs, the drainage is the yard, (p) for instance on the Banfield, when you go to change lanes, the rivets are so bad that you swerve when you change lanes, sometimes it can be difficult to control the car, (p) no, just those really

Because I just, I drive the freeways all the time and the city roads are a mess. They're always tearing up everything. They do patches and stuff and they don't do the whole thing over or anything, so you end up with a lot of potholes.

Because it seems like there's always traffic delays from all the work constantly going on.

Because of bike lanes mostly (P) I am a bike rider. One of my friends had a an accident because the lane was not maintained and now he is out of work so now I am being very cautious.

Because of the deterioration going on and the lack of repair. I also have a home in Clackamas County and it's very bad there. (p) Just the general condition of the roads.

Because of the way the highways are built, there's no proper pre-planning. For instance the St. Vincent interchange here at the end of Highway 217, 26 and 217 by the Saint Vincent's Hospital; they changed it I think four times since I've been living here twenty-seven years and they still haven't gotten it right, that place has always been a mess. In place of having the ramp that comes off Two-Seventeen that heads toward Hillsborough is a big sweeping curve heading back to Portland! Why in heavens couldn't they have made the ramp straight towards Hillsborough in place of having it sweep back towards Portland then curve back towards Hillsborough.

Because the bridges around here are in need of repair

Because the roads here are so bad. They need to fix those roads. (p) The roads in Medford (p) no, they're roads, they're Medford roads. Some roads are good, some are bad, there's no in-between.

Because there are some roads over here on the east side that haven't had anything done to them in 35 years and you can't get anything done to them because no big shots live on them there are some roads that, if a Volkswagen were driving on it, you'd find it at the bottom of a hole. it's that bad, and one of them the school bus uses. it's really bad.

Because there's too many pot holes and you go to Washington and it's much better.

Because they always choose interesting time to do work, they take too long. I see roads where they need improvement and don't touch it and then they work on a road I think doesn't need important.

Because they are always working on the roads, but get nothing done.

Because they are not looking ahead. Like before spaces have gotten built up. they should have widened highways beforehand.

Because they don't repair the roads and that's what the gas tax goes for.

Because they're somewhat bad. I'm not talking about highways, I'm talking about rural roads. <P> They're not being kept up and maintained.

Because whenever I drive on the sunset hwy , I-5 there is a lot of traffic, . I think they do a poor job of designing the intersection at hwy 217 to hwy 26

Cause all the roads suck, and then whenever they do tear up something to make it look better, they always fuck it up worse than it was. (p) like look at I-5, look at the Banfield Freeway, and then when they put asphalt on it, it fucks it up worse (p) their DOT regulations (p) look at them they are all messed up, like hours of service and everything (P) plus, I'm referring to their hours of service as being a truck driver

Chuckholes. they don't fix them in time. why do they have t do the whole street?

Have run across several roads that you could bust your car up on because of their condition

Have you ever been down by Lakeview area? The roads are terrible down there. (p) the highway, it's headed like you were going to go to Nevada.

I came out of California and the traffic up in Portland, I travel a lot, is terrible, and I don't think they have enough room to expand it. (p) no

I don't have a paved road even though I live one block off of highway 101.

I don't really pay attention

I don't use them that much. I don't go out.

I got a street that is lumpy

I just think it takes them too long to get projects done and some projects they don't bother with that need to get done

I live in Canby near Territorial road and there are some traffic lights that blink and they have not out a regular stop light. There have been many accidents with fatalities.

I live in Portland. The streets in downtown .they are in bad shape.

I think ODOT has sold out they look more to political brownie points

I think their sign-age...The Bend parkway project is atrocious. It's hard to read and follow directions. They can be more clear and we need more of it. I would like more bike trails and sidewalks. I have a lot of employees who ride bikes and we need more bikes. It's actually dangerous to ride a bike in Bend.

I think they spend more than they need to for the work they really do, like the Ferry Street Bridge. millions of dollars and it is not a big improvement.

I travel 58 and they let a cable company rip it up and I know we are going to have to pay for it.

I'm a truck driver (laughter) just the state of Oregon. I think for one thing I think they spend too much money on the roadways, on the highways, I just see a lot of waste. (p) The time their employees spend on the job sites and the things they complain about. Like the thing they're doing on I-Five by Salem, the concrete overlay. They're doing all of this road work and it's not going to do any good. I used to work road construction.

Issue of money potholes rough roads. Project takes a long time like I-5 in Salem, they been working 7 years

It seems that there is stuff that does not get done. our state highways are about a c- in terms of upkeep and repairs and potholes

It's hard to it looks good sometimes and it looks bad sometimes

I've been in other states and this doesn't get its money's worth.

Just the chuck holes and the surfacing of the road. I understand it's a funding problem.

Just the experience with them being out of repair. I guess one is their plan on the repair of I-5 between Salem and Albany. Endorsing light-rail in the Portland area.

Just the roads that I travel have been not kept up, lots of potholes and I see money being spent in places that aren't really needed when I see roads with those types of conditions. (p) Gosh all around southern Oregon, North Phoenix Road, North Foothills Road, I don't know if they're state. (p) Medford is trying to build this overpass and it's costing twelve million dollars and yet they're having a dispute over the land on the other side of the overpass so it may not end up going anywhere.

Look at it. it's self evident, planning and building is for 1985, planning and reaction behind the times, They need to look at Walt Disney structure

More attention to the northern metro and less rural areas.

Most of the roads I drive have potholes and patches and the highways have deep grooves.

Not doing their job

Originally I lived in Medford we had problems getting the transportation dept to approve different projects that we needed

Ruts, rough roads, not good signage, (p) no, I guess not

Seems like a lot of repairs are needed, not being done, taking a lot of time to fix landslides

Seems to be a lot of inadequate design, freeways, local roads not in good shape. no plans to remedy them

Some of the highways are...If a new shopping center comes in they will fix them. But they don't fix the roads around the house. In the towns the roads need improvement. They're always patching them and coming back to patch them again...Then someone digs up the road to put in a sewer line. The utilities and the roads don't do things at the same time. They don't coordinate. Then we have parking problems where there is a mechanic shop where cars parks on both sides of the streets and then the trucks are unloading and then there is not enough room for the cars driving in the street. The cars coming off of a busy road onto the residential street and they can't get through because of the parked cars on either side of the street. Poor planning.

Some of the roads out there are pretty bad <P> grooves and paving in the Mt. Tabor district.

The construction takes too long

The potholes and different things out in the country (p) no, well, some of the culverts and bridges in the smaller roads don't get maintained sometimes

The roads are breaking down and they are not kept up. They let potholes get worse before they fix it.

The roads are in terrible condition, the roads are overcrowded, I mean Sunset Hwy is an absolute disaster. I cannot see the light rail has helped as far as driving the roads in this area at all, I do ride light rail, but going in areas where I cannot ride light rail, the roads are atrocious, the traffic is terrible, if they are bringing in these people to work in these high tech companies then why aren't the high tech companies helping to pay to improve the roads for everyone who lives here? but we are turning around and giving these companies huge tax breaks. (p) that's fine

The roads suck

The roads where I live are in bad condition  
The rutting and feed and speed of repairs are slow  
The south coast does not get any help. It all goes to Portland and Salem. When the fed a lot money to the state for the roads, it goes to Portland and Salem, but it never comes here. They say it is a county problem, but the county doesn't get any money.  
There are a lot of roads that need help  
There potholes they don't take good enough care of the roads  
There's the quality of the highways of the roads and highways not very good quality. There's a lot of pot holes.  
They are not keeping up with the amount of traffic. They are not building roads to the extent that they need to handle traffic flows.  
They could do a much better job than they are doing.  
They don't have enough money to get the job done but they need to repair and maintain or it will cost 5 times as much.  
They don't maintain them.  
They have a huge problem in terms of getting the dollars necessary to put the black on the highway in terms of getting the money to fix things. They have a hate relationship with the Legislature and that needs to be fixed. They need to partner and ODOT (highway division in particular) need to correct ills that exist today.  
They haven't. I live near highway 18. It's a death trap because it is heavily traveled. there are 2 casinos, that has increased the traffic. Between McMinnville and Grandron there are a huge disproportion number of fatalities. We need two bypasses or something near Newburg and Dundee. On Friday night this is impossible. They haven't been given the money to do a good job.  
They're in bad disrepair potholes  
Umm, I don't know. That there's a stretch of 50 in Oregon where something doesn't need to be fixed.  
We lived North East corner and the roads here are poorly designed.  
Well because of the fact that number one they're usually behind considerable on repairs and the times they usually schedule these repair jobs are right in the middle of rush hour. (p) Portland metro area.  
Well for example some of the roads are caving away like out on Highway 34 between Philomath and Alsea, there's a lot of curves there and if you get close to the edge you'd slide over, sooner or later it's going to cave off.  
Well I see crews standing around without working 2 of them sleeping on the trees I see waste like that all the times. I see them doing construction jobs that take way to oolong and cost lots of doors dollars  
Well out here on the coast they are certainly not doing us any favors they are not maintaining the roads on hwy 20, hwy 101 and hwy 229.  
Well, all the money goes to Portland and Salem, we are trying to get a four-lane highway out here, in the 40's they bought the right of way for a four-lane highway, now they are trying to put a bypass here, which is the wrong thing to do  
Well, I live in downtown near the Lloyd center. There lots of people go to Lloyd center. they should not have construction on the weekend near shopping malls. there is a large amount of traffic going in and out  
Well, they raise our taxes every year on gas, cigarettes etc. for the highways and they keep getting worse. The roads are getting worse. But they raise our taxes every year to repair the roads but they don't fix em.  
Well, travelling over the roads, of course I understand the interstate is maintained with federal funds, but some of the state roads are in bad shape as well. there seems to be more emphasis on building new roads than on maintaining the ones they have  
Where I live at in Junction City they resurfaced the Harrisburg bridge they had the highway down to one lane for about 8 months and once it was finished it made no difference. The highways I use have a lot of potholes in them and they just patch them. It seems like they fix them on the fly just patching the problem rather than fixing it.  
Where I live it's the pot holes.  
With all the traveling on the roads where there is no snow, tires tear the roads up. It takes a long time to get out there and repair them.

Why (do you disagree)?

Because I think in any type of situation there's checks and balances and I think that the people should have a voice in what happens.

Because in the past they haven't. (p) Okay, Highway twenty-two, and Highway fifty-eight.

Because it is not very cost worthy. sometimes you have to wait so long when you have to hurry. <P> because they not have very much busses to cover all this time. Many streets are blocked off and many detours. You have to turn around long before you can drive right away.

Because it's never done. I mean they are always doing it. (PR) Road construction and maintenance. There seems to be certain roads that are forever ripped up and never completed and there are other roads that need maintenance really, really bad and are never touched.

Because of recent things they are proposing to do:(P) projects they are starting and not finishing. like the Ferry street bridge

Because of the conditions of the roads.

Because of the Sunnyside road fiasco, they promised to build but didn't

Because of the, two reasons: the collapse of the tunnel on highway 26 two or so years ago, the second: the low maintenance of the bridges in Portland.

Because the person doesn't know where all the income is going to maintain the transit and buses. I don't know if I can trust them because I don't feel that what I say counts. I feel kind of powerless. I feel like I have no say. They charge way too much for bus fare.

Because they don't do what is right. They build new highways and then tear the same highway up 6 months later. What are they thinking? It's a pain in the butt.

Because they repair constantly.

Because we need both those type of transportation train and highways

Cause they don't do you know. <P> They don't fill up the pot holes and smooth the road out. And they could do away with the bumps.

From like the 10 million dollars they squandered on trying to put a parkway through Eugene. Now they are not going to do it--poor planning. ODOT needs to be watched a little more.

I don't know who does the planning sometimes they do stuff and then they have to do it again. they need think more before they act.

I don't think hardly anybody in government can be trusted.

I guess in general driving you see some things that have been repaired road hazards that are not repaired

I have complaints about highways that are poorly designed

I just don't have to faith in government any more

I just drive on them everyday and I have not seen a gravel or snowplow on between Pendleton and Pilot Rock.

I just think they are not doing enough

I like to able to have some say in what is going on

I think sometimes their priorities for where they put the monies are not in mind of where they should be, I think they are swayed oftentimes by politics rather than where there is really a need

I think there are a lot of roads in the rural areas that are not kept up , This makes more people use the main highways and that is a another problem

I think they are wasting tax payers' money on things. They are working on things in the North but not in the South. It's not fair.

I think they try but I think they don't have the money , manpower, and community support to do what they need to do and it shows in the roads. I have lived in the east and their road conditions have always been better than here even though extreme weather and a larger population centers. Florida and New York for example.

If they can't get the materials to do the job, there is no way to maintain it.

In the travels that I have had in this corner of the state that I live in, I see a lot of monies and time spent in road improvement and maintenance that do nothing to improve the flow of traffic. (p) I live southwest of Portland.

In the valley they concentrate the fixing of roads in the valley. In eastern Oregon they neglect them.

I've been around them. I've seen too much bureaucracy and fix what needs to be fix. the chain of command is terrible.

I've been fighting with them for 20 years about them taking my business and nothing has ever been done .

I've had personal run-ins with ODOT. They used to handle airports in Oregon and they did a terrible job.

I've seen some of the thing they have done and I haven't approved of them and I just don't trust them. They should get it right the first time.

Mainly the reasons as before. I believe they take too long and re do roads that don't need fixing.

My husband was former mayor of this city, Banks, and his dealings with ODOT- not a lot of cooperation with city.

On highway 217 they had to redo it and taxpayers had to pay more.

Pretty much the same as I told you before, a waste of money.

Refer to previous comments made about the mudslides on Tugman hill on 101.

Same reason. <P> I drive a relatively major thoroughfares and I see DOT projects and it's hard to see why they don't ration out the project selection.

So far they haven't been able to do it, so much waste, my tax dollars are not being properly used. absolutely senseless . Some of our bridges are falling apart, it was just on channel 2 news here. about how unsafe most of the bridges in Oregon are, most of them are 30 years old or more. (p) our country roads and bridges are a lot better than the state roads and bridges, the state hires people to build roads and then they take them over and maintain them, maybe they ought to hire people to maintain them, because that works in other sectors (p) we'll just let it go, because I see what they do around here, you drive by and they don't seem to work that hard

That's a good question, I guess I go back to my first statement on the department of transportation not widening the freeways and pushing mass transit

The general condition of the roads in my area

There was a person who used to have a desk job and he was told to look busy before he left. He wasn't doing anything. To me that's a waste.

There's an issue about transportation, need to do better. I can't think now.

They aren't doing anything

They could do a lot more

They don't fix the roads

They don't have enough money to keep up the roads.

They don't they don't send them out and one road never gets fixed

They have a tendency to put things off until it's too late.

They performed poorly. (P) they are not good, all highways are not good.

They spent 3 months painting this highway they put the paint in the wrong place and had to repaint it. They had cones blocking traffic and no work was being done. It's ridiculous.

Too long building bridge in Rogue Valley and they don't address safety issues. Two lane highway that goes through town at 45 and slits at blinking sign for a school--Illinois Valley, in Cave Junction. People have been hurt already and all I get is lip service from ODOT.

Want to know where the money is coming from

We get screwed by them.

We have had our local DMV close. We've found out that several things we were told were not true. Don't feel like we can trust what they say.

Well like I say they haven't .Like banning snow tires and chains. It's legal to put them on now but there is no snow out there so why have them on. The chains are destroying the pavement real bad.

Well sometimes they don't do it. . lots of time they take a long time to do.

Well they haven't been doing it so you can't trust that it will be an automatic thing with them. They need a push to do what is right. The money from the gas tax is supposed to keep up the highways and evidently they are doing nothing with it.

Well, basically in my location I don't have think they have enough funds. I think they tend to funnel funds towards larger population areas like Portland.

Well, I work with a lot of engineers and I see things done backwards. the working man with experience sees them making mistakes because they don't experience. A good example coming into Corvallis. it is becoming very dangerous at the intersection of Oakville road and Highway 24. We have already had 1 accident and they are waiting for someone to get killed before they change it. We can't get out of our driveways now with the cranes because of the changes,. They felt that people would not see the red light in time if they were westbound. But you can see way back a quarter mile or so. They said the angle was too sharp. And I have seen roads with stoplights on them with the same angle in Portland. They just didn't want to spend the money or slow down traffic

Well, the road to Mt. Ashland for instance is a wonderful, beautiful, terrific road. Some of these roads that the loggers and truckers use are going to hell. I feel they are servicing roads for the tourists and not for people who live and work here. Mt. Bachelor is the same way.

Well, they just don't seem to fix a lot of things. We got a slide down here outside of Coos Bay, they've got the highway into one lane and it's been that way for quite a while now. (p) Not right offhand.

When you go by a road crew one guy working, 10 sit around doing nothing. money is wasted. take too long to do one project. slow too many supervisors not enough workers.

Why (do you say that)?

As usual, when you leave decisions up to government, they rarely get them right. (p) People who are making decisions at ODOT are not out driving the roads everyday. They'd be better off bringing up some of those guys driving the roadway everyday and getting their input.

Because of the way I was treated in my business by their attorneys. Not the guy on the road, but the guy in the tie across the table, cutthroat negative bastard, acquisition of property in Salem.

Because their timing is bad. Pick the wrong time of the year and wrong time of the day to do things.

Because they are not maintaining the areas. they do for Portland but no us. they are maintaining the new part of Highway 229 but not the old part of Highway 229

Been here one month

Cause they don't seem to be able to fix the problems.

Don't use them enough

I don't drive - too old

I don't enough info to answer that

I don't fully know what the transportation dep. does

I don't have a choice they are going to do what they are going to do anyway.

I don't know that much about the transportation department

I don't pay attention.

I don't trust any government agency to do what is right.

I don't trust government period.

I feel that there's too much time spent on the jobs doing nothing. I have even reported to Washington County where I live the fact that men are sitting on the side of the road at any time of the day lollygaging' sitting in their trucks two or three of them acting like they're on break but you can't tell me this is happening many times of the day.

You can't get work done by leaning on their shovels lollygaging' at the sides of the roads, or sitting in parked vehicles spending time that needs to be spent working. Too much time is wasted by the workers.

I feel that they make decisions without enough public input and hearings from the neighborhoods they impact.

I think they, the highway department is more concerned with it's own interests. (p) They're more interested in doing stuff to make them look good instead of doing the right thing. (p) They'd rather do anything than actually wait and figure out how to do it right. (p) Take a look at Highway 217 and either Sunset or I-5, they keep fooling around over there but they never fix it (laughter). (p) They're both on-ramps onto other freeways.

I'm not that knowledgeable about the topic.

It goes back to design and planning. Some of their experimental road surfaces are a disaster.

It goes back to the decisions I see being made with the money they have. The overpasses.

It has a lot to do with my previous experience with ODOT. Widening roads in scenic areas and destroying the landscape.

I've seen their work I'm not impressed.

Just cause they always mess up shit, and then they take forever to fix it,

My experience I've had

Right is too vague. Do you mean right morally or right cost effective? I don't know what they mean by right.

Same reason as stated before. See previous comments about the ODOT.

Should be new construction to accommodate new comers

Sometimes the bus information is not efficient. They leave you waiting on the phone forever.

They are more into payoffs because of the decisions they have made recently

They don't justify what they spend their money for they have not accounted for the money they have spent.

They probably don't do much anyway

They're gonna do what they're gonna do

Well because I feel I get heavy traffic. People are moving to Oregon and the demand using highways is high

Well because they don't do that. I think they get their little buddies together and decide what they are going to do. they don't care what the voters want

Well I don't get too involved and don't get involved in that stuff, politics and things that go on around here.

Well I don't travel that much.

Well, I just don't see what they are doing most of the time. They are supposed to be fixing our roads and I don't see any improvements.

Well, there again, money talks, and the people in the big cities get all the gravy so to speak, out of Salem towards the hills they put a highway so they can vacation on weekends, we have more traffic out here, they killed three or four people out here before they put a passing lane in the middle

### INTERVIEWER: PLEASE RECORD ANYTHING R SAID THAT IS RELEVANT TO THE SURVEY'S PURPOSES.

"I see a lot of people here who need help on some environmental issues, or food, or transportation around here, and it would be nice if more help was available to them" She had commented on how her community had depended on logging, but since the woods were basically shut down, people were still getting by, but some of them were having a hard time. She pointed out that if industry came into their community, more pollution would likely result, than if they had continued logging. She also said that from the questions asked, she became more aware of environment concerns, the lottery, etc.

Despite repeating questions and probing and following all interviewer manual suggestions, the male respondent could barely give a straight answer. Very strenuous interview. Open-ended questions were repeatedly-repeated!

Did not want to take survey, had "attitude".

EMPLOY- Respondent does not consider taking care of her elderly mother "keeping house". So "Other". DISAB1-

Respondent does not consider old age to be a "disability" but after hearing our probe she answered "Yes".

For distance to work question, R does not work at home, but works at the store right next to her home

For distance to work, respondent said 1/4 mile -- that is closer to 0 than 1 but she does not work at home which is the code for 0 but I coded it a 0

For media question, R said WWW and radio, then specified short-wave worldband radio For first survey question, R said "How about amusing?"

For question: are you registered to vote? R said she doesn't like vote-by-mail because she knows a few people who forgot to send in their ballots, and felt that if everyone had to go to a precinct on the same day, it would more likely encourage people to vote

For survey question, R said, "They are a nuisance"

For the last two questions, R said that it depended on what the results would be used for and who was sponsoring the survey. He really wanted to say "it depends", but upon probing, he said "somewhat" and "no impact".

He spend a lot of time coughing, repeated questions

I live in an assisted living residence and my wife is across the street in the nursing home with Parkinson's.

Just a note: 2 out of 4 respondents today got their main news from the WWW.

ODOT1B- Respondent said "Both" building new highways and maintaining existing ones is important, refused to choose. PARK13, PARK14, PARK15- R offered she doesn't get the newspaper, and doesn't have a television or a computer so all her answers were 2 "No". FOOD2- Respondent offered that she grows organic food and upon repeating the question twice she reluctantly answered 2 "Sometimes".

On ODOT maintenance, he said city repairs are not as good as the freeways. Also, he sees 15 guys doing one man's work. On OILB: he commented that he believed we will have to ration fuel on a worldwide basis, but because there is no rationing yet, he thinks we will have enough in 25 years.

On Vote 3 the R said he didn't read the Voter's Guide, it was too big. There wasn't an answer category for that so I entered don't know.

Parks are important for families although I don't get to them much myself. Surveys and polls can have a significant negative impact on us because I can go down and buy all sorts of information on people and how they vote.

R also lives in Clackamas County.

R camped in a pickup truck camper

R did not want to choose on Oil question. She felt the choices between 15 and 25 years were too extreme and not very accurate.

R felt that Highway 20 in Lincoln County needs to be rebuilt.

R felt that Lottery, transportation, parks and poverty should all be separate surveys, with more detail.

R felt that the Voter's Guide should list ballot measures in one booklet and list arguments in a separate booklet.

R from Vietnam [I asked out of curiosity]

R got very frustrated when I asked him why he said neutral for one question. He said, because he was in the middle, he said neutral because they (transport. dept.) were average, and we didn't have that response

R is concerned over the fee system going into place at Oregon State Parks. he feels it won't generate any revenue or as much as is expected because the number of people who use the parks will drop due to the fees. On the number of ballot measures he wanted to add that the initiative process is what determines how many measures are on the ballots so he felt the question was inaccurate because he felt we were really asking about the initiative process and not about how he felt regarding the number of ballots.

R mentioned that even though lottery pays for half of parks budget, while it does not effect her opinion of parks, does not want money coming from lottery used for it.

R refused to answer OR Lottery question 1 because he felt he didn't have enough information. he wanted to know where the money goes.

R said Albany Democrat-Herald for his newspaper, I forgot to enter it. Also he wanted it known that for the amount of money ODOT has he feels they do an excellent job. That they ( the agency) needs to be funded at a higher level.

R said for the 2 questions she answered don't know to that she didn't have a basis to compare them to be able to answer.

R said he felt the building of more roads/highways should be done because there is not enough of the roads/highways that are specifically built to deal with mass transit issues in the metropolitan area.

R said he felt the Voter's Guide was a pack of lies, had inaccuracies in the statements.

R said he had a somewhat negative view of state parks because of the abuse some people do to them, like vandalizing bathrooms, etc. For the question on how important surveys are, he said it depends, this one important, some not important.

R said he picked somewhat important on Ending 2 but would prefer if he could put it into his own words which were "I would say that they are important if they ( surveys) end up doing what they are supposed to, what they are intended for then I would say they are somewhat important."

R said he said neutral because it wasn't applicable to him

R said in the case of fees at Oregon State Parks he felt they were just about right except in a few cases. he wanted it noted that he disagrees with the day use fee at places like Florence where people go to use ATV's. R felt the fee is okay for ATV users who are there for dune riding but the fee is unfair for people just coming down to look at the beachfront or walk on the beach.

R said on each of his "don't know" responses that he felt he did not have enough information on that to give a response. On OR Parks he said there should be more of them and that he disagrees with the state handing over management of the parks to an outside agency.

R said on the importance of surveys he would have to know what the importance or purpose of the survey was if he were to know if it were important or not.

R said on the VOTE 4 question she would want to know how the research or if the research were being used for any practical purpose to respond. On the Oregon Lottery she wanted to add that she feels the lottery encourages gambling and is offended by how much the OR lottery pushes it on people. R felt that it encourages a vice that destroys families.

R said she didn't have enough information to give an answer on the two questions she answered don't know to on this survey.

R said she felt the voter descriptions were understandable but that there were inaccuracies in the Voter's Guide. Also, on the number of ballot measures she felt that the number was okay only because she was able to vote from home. She said if she had to vote on that many ballot measures at the polls she would have been frustrated.

R said she has no disability, although earlier she mentioned a few times that she is legally blind. also, she lives in an assisted living center, but has her own apartment and phone

R said state needs to do better job in recruiting senior directors and managers of agencies. R said the state legislature needs to quit being so partisan and do the right things for Oregon. We have partisanship that's terrible at this point and a lack of ability to really work with the agencies to move things forward. Also, R wanted it noted that he answered neutral on the ODOT and OR Lottery performance questions because 1) for ODOT it depends on where in the state you are talking about to be able to say how well they are maintaining roads, etc. and 2) for the OR Lottery R had a conceptual dichotomy over answering how well they are doing as state agency doing their job versus the idea of how the Lottery is set up to fund things.

R said that we will be out of oil in 15 years and we will be buying it from Saddam. R lives in a dorm at U of O

R said, "You didn't ask me any questions about law enforcement".

R seemed confused about a lot of the questions. She asked me a lot of questions and gave a lot of 'don't know' responses. At times, it seemed to me that she was just giving answers because she was embarrassed that she didn't know what I was talking about or what the questions were asking.

R thought environmental questions were poorly worded.

R wanted to know who sponsored the survey.

R wanted to say on VOTE 4 that the voter's pamphlet was lies, and felt the people who put it together were incompetent. He said the word irony was used in the exact opposite context of its meaning so after he read that in the Voter's Guide he disregarded the pamphlet as an accurate source.

R was unsure about the first set of questions re: state agencies because he is here as a foreign exchange student.

R was very analytical with some questions; for example, he thought the word "environment" was ambiguous, because it has several connotations; also, check out his "first thought or image" about global warming!

R wasn't familiar with global warming, Oregon Lottery, etc.

R(F) didn't know about the level of income and if she paid her bills late because her mom was in charge of that. She was 18 years old

Refused to answer questions pertaining to income and poverty, said this is not an agency, so refused. Referred to frequently asked ?, but still refused

Respondent commented when he answered OILB that he believes we will have plenty of oil in twenty five years because he knows "an oil man". On GLOWARM his first thought when he heard the term 'global warming' was "Farce".

Respondent is an international student. English is her second language. Respondent said for FEELOTB and NEUT3 that she feels "neutral" about the Lottery because she doesn't have enough information about the lottery. I think this may also be why she took a long time to answer LOTT1B and then finally said "trees", and I suspect that her answer was more in response to the word "Oregon" rather than to "Lottery", as she gave the same answer "trees" for PARK1B.

Respondent may not have understood global warming question and probe answer may not be applicable.

Respondent offered for SAVMO10 that "that comes first" and answered 2 "No" they hadn't gone without medical treatment or medicines. At the end of the interview, while coughing, Respondent offered that she is recovering from pneumonia.

Respondent offered for VOLUNTER1 that her answer was 2 "No" because she is disabled, and her answer for EMPLOY was no, she doesn't work because she is 6 "Disabled"; but her answer for DISABL1 was 2 "No" no one is permanently disabled. Respondent was having a coughing spell.

Respondent offered that he drives truck through Oregon and he used to do road construction, which he implied in MAINTBA affects his opinions on the Oregon Department of Transportation. His job driving truck may also affect many of his opinions on the environment, including for OILA where he answered 2 "used up in 15 years", and he indicated a desire for industry regulation in his answer for GLOWARM.

Respondent reads the Oregonian newspaper.

Respondent refused all Q's after income, except about surveys.

She commented that she was upset that that ODOT often repairs the wrong streets. they worked on her street, 2nd and Siskiyou in Portland when it was fine and did not repair other nearby streets that were in much worse shape.

She said she is a member of the NRA, where they kill excess ducks and clean up roads, thus considered that an environmental club.
