INDEX/SUMMARY THREE -BUILDINGS SORTED BY NAMES OF THE ARCHITECT/DESIGNERS

Instructions:

This index/summary is sorted alphabetically by the names of the architect/designers. Until 1919 when "Architect" was legally-defined in Oregon, the title could be used by persons with little architectural training or experience. Some contractors who also designed buildings used the term "Contracting Architect", though this term does not dependably imply a design role on each project. The likelihood that a Contracting Architect had a design role for a specific building might be inferred by referring to that person's other work, including any listings as a contractor (see Index/Summary Four below). The role of other persons who similarly engaged in both design and construction is also categorized here as "contracting", even if that person was not described as a Contracting Architect. The spelling of architect's names was verified in contemporary directories and used consistently for all entries in the database to eliminate the variations and errors reported in the original references. Architects whose name does not appear first in the name of their firm might be overlooked in a search of the alphabetical listings, so the following list links these architects with their firms' names.

Multiple references to a particular building are grouped so that all references to that building appear together, organized by date. To group this information, the name of the building had to be identical in all records in the database. To distinguish different buildings which otherwise would have had identical names, the building permit number or other information was added in parenthesis following the name. Additions in brackets are alternate names reported for the building. Names and addresses of buildings were not always reported consistently from one reference to the next. In these cases, a "best" name and address had to be selected in order to link and group information about the same building. The address on a building permit was usually favored over other addresses. Some names and addresses are composites of the information in different references that appear to refer to the same building. Decisions regarding these choices and linkages were made conservatively, but some errors may have resulted. If this is suspected, the individual references should be consulted for specific variations, since not all repetitive information was printed in the index/summary. Addresses listed in other references are available on-line in the computer's database. The one-line summary for each reference may include the addresses of contractors. These addresses appear as reported and were not converted to current addresses; see Appendix A. for conversioons. The summary line is followed by the one word note [+ "much", "some", "minor", or "none"] which indicates how much additional information is contained in the referenced documents. Data in Index/Summary Three is complete, so it is not necessary to refer to Index/Summary Two (A) or (B) for additional information.
