### DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR DEADLINE TO APPEAL: September 5, 2006

This amendment was not submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption. Pursuant to OAR 660-18-060, the Director or any person is eligible to appeal this action to LUBA under ORS 197.830 to 197.845.

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4187, FIGURE III-1, THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN LAND USE MAP AND ORDINANCE NO. 2050, THE ZONING MAP FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 8111 SW WEST SLOPE; CPA2006-0002/ZMA 2006-0001

- WHEREAS, This property annexed to the City of Beaverton, through Ordinance 4341 in March 2005, thus the property is being redesignated in this ordinance from the County's land use designation to the closest corresponding City designation as specified by the Urban Planning Area Agreement (UPAA); and
- WHEREAS, Since the UPAA is specific on the appropriate designations for this parcel, this is not a discretionary land use decision and therefore no public hearing is required; and
- WHEREAS, The Council adopts as to criteria applicable to this request and findings thereon the Community Development Department staff report by Senior Planner Barbara Fryer, dated June 22, 2006, attached hereto as Exhibit B; now, therefore,

### THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Ordinance No. 4187, the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map, is amended to designate the subject property located at 8111 SW West Slope (Tax Map 1S101BB, Lot 00100) Neighborhood Residential Standard Density on the City of Beaverton Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map, as shown on Exhibit "A" and in accordance with the UPAA.
- Section 2. Ordinance No. 2050, the Zoning Map, is amended to designate the same property in Section 1 Residential 7,000 square foot minimum land area per dwelling unit (R-7) on the City of Beaverton Zoning Map, as shown on Exhibit "A" and in accordance with the UPAA.
