Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: February 8, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.625 (1), 197.830 (2), and 197.830 (9) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS ADOPTED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD.

ORDINANCE NO. NS-1993

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BEND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. NS-1178 (ZONING MAP), BY CHANGING THE ZONING DESIGNATION OF A PARCELS OF LAND AS SHOWN IN EXHIBIT "A" FROM UAR, URBAN AREA RESERVE, TO RS, STANDARD DENSITY RESIDENTIAL.

THE CITY OF BEND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Bend City Council has held a public hearing, considered the Hearings Officer's findings and record, and has found that there is a public need and benefit for the proposed change. The Bend City Council adopts the Findings and Recommendation of the Hearings Officer dated November 23, 2005 file number PZ-05-430.

Section 2. Section 7(1) of Ordinance NS-1178 and the Zoning Map of the City of Bend are amended by changing the designation of the property described as Tax Assessor's Map 18-12-18BA, Tax Lots 600, 700, 800 and Tax Map 18-12-18BB, Tax Lots 100, 200, 400, 500, 600 and shown in Exhibit "A". The change will be from Urban Area Reserve (UAR) to Urban Standard Density Residential (RS).


