Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: March 20, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

NOTICE OF DECISION

This is official notice of action taken by the Happy Valley City Council at a public hearing on February 21, 2006, with regard to an application by the City of Happy Valley, for an amendment to the Rock Creek Comprehensive Plan.

At the public hearing, the City Council formally approved the subject application based upon findings included within the Staff Report dated February 21, 2006, public testimony and deliberations of the City Council.

This action of the City Council is subject to appeal to the State of Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals. An appeal of this decision must be filed within 21 days of the mailing of this Notice of Decision. City Planning Department staff (503-760-3325) can provide information regarding forms, fees, and the appeal process. Issues, which may provide the basis for an appeal to the Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals, shall be submitted in writing, accompanied by appropriate filing fees, prior to the expiration of the appeal period. Issues shall be raised with sufficient specificity to enable the Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals to respond to the issue. If no appeal is filed by March 20, 2006, at 4:00 p.m., this decision shall be deemed final.

Per direction provided by the City Council on Tuesday, February 21, 2006 – the following text changes, as well as implementation of the hand-drawn alterations have been adopted by the City of Happy Valley, effective March 23, 2006.


Page 17 Local Streets (changed to read)

"It is not the purpose of this Comprehensive Plan to design the local street network, but instead to establish the parameters under which these streets should be provided. Local streets are to be provided at a minimum spacing of 10 to 16 streets per mile (every 330 to 530 feet) in order to support neighborhood connectivity.

A minimum of three local street connections to SE 152nd. Avenue-south of Sunnyside Road is essential to connect the residential neighborhoods with civic and commercial activities planned for the Rock Creek area. These connections are needed to provide internal access without requiring added trips onto Sunnyside Road. The connection should be made-from SE 157th and/or SE-162nd. Avenues. These streets will be planned concurrent with the specific development proposals in the Rock Creek Area.

Topographic and environmental conditions limit the level of connectivity in several areas of Happy Valley south of Sunnyside Road between Rock Creek and 152nd

Avenue and are recognized as being particularly problematic, and may require exceptional treatment to avoid overloading of narrow local streets."

ORDINANCE NO. 330

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ROCK CREEK COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF HAPPY VALLEY – OREGON TRAIL DRIVE/ELINOR STREET CONNECTIONS

THE CITY OF HAPPY VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Application LDO-11-05 was a staff initiated request to amend the Rock Creek Comprehensive Plan as detailed within Attachment "A"; and

WHEREAS a hearing was held before the City of Happy Valley Planning Commission on October 11, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission unanimously recommended the changes to the Rock Creek Comprehensive Plan as detailed in the Staff Report dated October 11, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City has forwarded a copy of the proposed amendments to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Happy Valley, Oregon, has determined that it is reasonable, necessary and in the public interest to amend the Rock Creek Comprehensive Plan pursuant to the findings within Attachment "A" at the regular meeting of the City Council on February 21, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby declared by the City Council of Happy Valley, Oregon, that the City's Rock Creek Comprehensive Plan be amended as set forth as part of Attachment "A"; as amended by the City Council on February 21, 2006; and, is fully incorporated herein.

BE IT FURTHER declared that this Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after approval by the City Council.

READ for the first time at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Happy Valley, Oregon, on February 21, 2006 and read for the second time on February 21, 2006, and adopted by unanimous vote of the members of the City Council of the City of Happy Valley, Oregon.
