## DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: October 3, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

\*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

# ORDINANCE NO. 119 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE IDANHA COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP AND ZONING MAP

Whereas, the City of Idanha received a request to amend the Comprehensive Plan Map designation from Industrial to Residential and change the zoning from Industrial to Residential on 67 acres of a 74-acre tract, identified as Township 10S Range 6E Tax Lot 2700 and Township 10S, Range 6E, Section 15CC, Tax Lot 100; and

Whereas, the area subject to this request is located within the Idanha Urban Growth Boundary, is designated as Industrial on the Idanha Comprehensive Plan Map, and the portion subject to the rezoning request is zoned Industrial; and

Whereas, the City Council conducted a public hearing to consider the request on May 8, 2006 at which time the public was given full opportunity to be present and heard on the matter; and

Whereas, at the close of the public hearing, the City Council voted to approve the request; and

Whereas, proper notice of the said public hearing was given to the public pursuant to applicable state statutes; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Idanha hereby adopts the findings of fact set forth in the staff report presented at the May 8, 2006 public hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE,

## THE CITY OF IDANHA ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

That the property and lands described in Exhibit A is hereby designated as Residential on the Idanha Comprehensive Plan Map and the zoning is hereby changed from Industrial to Residential. The property and lands described in Exhibit B remain Industrial on the Idanha Comprehensive Plan Map and the Idahna Zoning Map.

This ordinance shall become in full force and effect on and after its passage by the Council of the City of Idanha and the signature thereon by the Mayor of the City of Idanha.




