# **DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: June 7, 2006**

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 343

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP AND ZONING MAP FOR CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY FRANK VANDERZANDEN IN THE CITY OF NORTH PLAINS, WASHINGTON COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City has received an application from Frank Vanderzanden for a Comprehensive Plan Map amendment from Commercial (COMM) to High Density Residential (R-2.5) and zoning map amendment to Multi-Family Residential (R-2.5) on property described on the map and legal description attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A", pursuant to Chapter 16.50 of the City Zoning and Development Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on December 14, 2005 on the application and recommended approval of a change of zone to R-2.5, Multi-Family Residential to the City Council. The City Council conducted the final public hearing on January 17, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed amendments comply with the goals and policies of the Comprehensive Plan and the requirements of the Zoning and Development Ordinance.

#### THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NORTH PLAINS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City of North Plains Comprehensive Plan Map is hereby amended by the redesignation of the property described and shown in Exhibit A.
- 2. The City of North Plains Zoning Map is hereby amended by the rezoning of the property described and shown in Exhibit A.
- 3. The City Council hereby adopts by this reference the Final Findings and Order dated January 11, 2006.
- 4. There shall be a development agreement recorded on the title of the property requiring any development of the property to go through the Design Review procedures outlined in the zoning and development ordinance.


