Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR DEADLINE TO APPEAL: July 11, 2007

This amendment was not submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption. Pursuant to OAR 660-18-060, the Director or any person is eligible to appeal this action to LUBA under ORS 197.830 to 197.845.

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

Amendment (ZMA 2007-0012)

Ordinance 4442 (attached), adopting the subject amendments, was passed by the City Council after second reading on the <u>June 18, 2007</u> Council agenda. The assigned zoning district designation is consistent with the Washington County – Beaverton Urban Planning Area Agreement (UPAA) and no discretion was exercised its assignment to the subject properties. The Mayor approved and signed Ordinance 4442 on <u>June 19, 2007</u>, which is the legal date of final decision.

Appeal. Any appeal of this final decision should be made to the State of Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) as provided in ORS 197.830 through ORS 197.845. A notice of intent to appeal shall be filed not later than 21 calendar days after notice of the decision is mailed or otherwise submitted to parties entitled to notice under ORS 197.615. Mailing of the notice on Wednesday, June 20, 2007 results in an appeal deadline of Thursday, July 11, 2007.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2050, THE ZONING MAP FOR TWO PROPERTIES LOCATED IN NORTHERN BEAVERTON; ZMA2007-0012

- WHEREAS, The site containing the subject properties was annexed to the City of Beaverton through Boundary Commission Ordinance 3978 in 1998, and is being redesignated in this ordinance from Washington County's land use designation to the closest corresponding City designation in accordance with the Washington County Beaverton Urban Planning Area Agreement (UPAA); and
- WHEREAS, Since the UPAA is specific on the appropriate City Zoning Map designation for the parcels, this is not a discretionary land use decision and no public hearing is required; and
- WHEREAS, the Council incorporates herein by reference the Community Development Department staff report on ZMA2007-0012 by Associate Planner Jeff Salvon dated June 4, 2007; now, therefore

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2050, the Zoning Map, is amended to rezone the subject properties located north of Highway 26, south of SW Barnes Road, and east of SW Baltic Avenue Office Commercial (OC) as shown on Exhibit "A" in accordance with the Washington County — Beaverton Urban Planning Area Agreement (UPAA).
