Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: February 21, 2007

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

- *<u>NOTE:</u> THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

- 4. Submittal of this Notice of Adoption must include the text of the amendment plus adopted findings and supplementary information.
- 5. The deadline to appeal will be extended if you submit this notice of adoption within five working days of the final decision. Appeals to LUBA may be filed within **TWENTY-ONE (21) days** of the date the "Notice of Adoption" is sent to DLCD.
- 6. In addition to sending the "Notice of Adoption" to DLCD, you must notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision.

ORDINANCE #660

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF CARLTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP AND ZONING MAP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Carlton received a request to amend the Comprehensive Plan designation and rezone an approximately 1.36-acre property, identified as Township 3S, Range 4W, Section 22, Tax Lot 1600; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located within the Carlton city limits, is designated as Agricultural Holding on the Carlton Comprehensive Plan Map, and is zoned Agricultural Holding; and

WHEREAS, a request was made to change the Comprehensive Plan Map designation to Commercial and to change the zoning on the property to Commercial Business;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing to consider the request on November 6, 2006 at which time the public was given full opportunity to be present and heard on the matter; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the public hearing, the Planning Commission voted to recommend that the City Council approve the request; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing to consider the request on December 11, 2006 at which time the public was given full opportunity to be present and heard on the matter; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the public hearing, the City Council voted to approve the request; and

WHEREAS, proper notice of the said public hearings was given to the public pursuant to applicable state statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Carlton hereby adopts the findings of fact set forth in the staff report dated December 4, 2006;

NOW THEREFORE; The people of the City of Carlton ordain as follows;

SECTION 1. The Comprehensive Plan Map designation for the subject property is hereby changed from Agricultural Holding to Commercial.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The zoning designation for the subject property is hereby changed from Agricultural Holding to Commercial Business.

<u>SECTION 3. Emergency Clause.</u> The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace, and safety of the City of Carlton that this ordinance take

effect at once, and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
