Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: May 29, 2007

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*<u>NOTE:</u> THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

ORDINANCE NO. 360 CITY OF NORTH PLAINS, OREGON

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY INTO THE CITY CONSISTENT WITH ORS CHAPTER 222, THE STATEWIDE PLANNING GOALS AND THE NORTH PLAINS COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of North Plains received an application for annexation on October 20, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to ORS 197.610, OAR Chapter 660-Division 18 and Senate Bill 543 notice of proposed amendment was mailed to DLCD on October 26, 2006.

WHEREAS, Sections 16.59.080 and 16.59.090 of the North Plains Zoning and Development Ordinance requires hearings by the Planning Commission and City Council for annexations; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on the proposed annexation on December 13, 2006 and recommended to the City Council that the proposed annexation be approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing and approved the proposed annexation on December 18, 2006, and passed Resolution 1356 approving the annexation for placement on the March 13, 2007 special election ballot; and

WHEREAS, under ORS 222.160 the City Council finds that a majority of the votes cast at the March 13, 2007 election were in favor of the proposed annexation,

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the following,

The City of North Plains ordains as follows:

Section 1. The City Council declares and proclaims that the territory described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B is annexed to the City of North Plains.

Section 2. The City Recorder is directed to:

A. File the following with the Secretary of State and Department of Revenue:

1. A copy of this Ordinance;

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2. An abstract of the annexation vote showing the whole number of electors voting, the number of votes cast in favor of annexation, and the number of votes cast against annexation;

3. A copy of the land owner statement(s) of consent.

B. Mail a copy of this Ordinance to Washington County, to all service providers and to any other parties entitled to receive notice of its adoption.

Section 3. Pursuant to Chapter VIII of the North Plains Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect on the thirtieth day after its passage by the City Council.


