Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Thursday, June 25, 2009

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

- 5. The deadline to appeal will not be extended if you submit this notice of adoption within five working days of the final decision. Appeals to LUBA may be filed within **TWENTY-ONE** (21) days of the date, the Notice of Adoption is sent to DLCD.
- 6. In addition to sending the Notice of Adoption to DLCD, you must notify persons who participated in the local hearing and requested notice of the final decision.

CITY OF REDMOND ORDINANCE NO. 2009-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REDMOND DEVELOPMENT CODE BY ADOPTING REGULATIONS THAT MAKE PARKS A PERMITTED USE IN ALL RESIDENTIAL ZONES; ESTABLISHES ADDITIONAL USES FOR THE PUBLIC FACILITY (PF) ZONE; ALLOWS RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS IN THE FAIRGROUNDS (FG) ZONE; RESTRICTS BUILDING HEIGHTS WITHIN 100 FEET OF A RESIDENTIAL ZONE; CLARIFIES PARKING CALCULATIONS FOR THE DOWNTOWN DESIGN OVERLAY ZONE AND CORRECTS A MISTAKE IN THE SECTION NUMBERING OF THE DEVELOPMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has adopted Chapter 8 of the Redmond Code which is more commonly known as the Redmond Development Code (RDC); and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Development Code, including all amendments thereto, has been acknowledged by the State of Oregon as being in compliance with State Law and the applicable statewide planning goals; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time to amend the Redmond Development Code to provide for new zoning regulations and to make necessary corrections to the Code; and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Urban Area Planning Commission held a public hearing on March 2, 2009, and has recommended that the Redmond City Council adopt certain housekeeping regulations and to make corrections to the zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received the Planning Commission's recommendation and, after receiving additional evidence and testimony, determined that the requested amendments would correct mistakes in the Development Code and clarify the allowed uses in the Public Facility, Residential and Fairgrounds zones; and

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that the proposed findings for the adoption of the Redmond Development Code amendments has fully addressed the City's Comprehensive Plan, the applicable state law, the statewide planning goals and the City's standards and criteria for an amendment to the Redmond Development Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF REDMOND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City of Redmond hereby amends the Redmond Development Code Chapter 8, Article I – Zoning Standards and corrects the section numbering in Article IV – Site and Design Review Standards by adopting the amendments which are attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

SECTION TWO: In support of the adopted zone text amendments in Section One, the City of Redmond hereby adopts the findings which are attached hereto as "Exhibit B" which were prepared by City staff and demonstrate compliance with the Redmond Development Code Section 8.0760 – <u>Criteria for Amendments</u>, the City's Comprehensive Plan, and the applicable statewide planning goals.
