This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

### CITY OF REDMOND ORDINANCE NO. 2008-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8 – DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, ARTICLE I – ZONING STANDARDS, ARTICLE IV – SITE AND DESIGN REVIEW STANDARDS, ARTICLE V – SIGN STANDARDS.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Redmond's Urban Renewal Agency adopted URD Resolution No. 2006-06, the 2006 Downtown Action Plan Update, and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Downtown Action Plan Update included recommendations to amend the Redmond Development Code as it pertained to the C2 (Central Business District) Zone, and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Downtown Action Plan Update provided the following intent statements to guide the amendments to the Redmond Development Code as it pertained to the C2 (Central Business District) Zone: encourage a vibrant mix of pedestrian-oriented uses, including residential, shopping and entertainment uses; increase the density and intensity of development; establish height, bulk, and lot coverage regulations that balance existing urban fabric with a desired character for Downtown; promote active ground floors by regulating the quantity and location of doors and windows; establish standards for setbacks and landscaping that encourage and promote a strong pedestrian environment; establish parking and access standards that support pedestrian activity, and

WHEREAS, one of the Economic Development goals of the Redmond 2020 Comprehensive Plan, adopted by the City of Redmond on May 22, 2001, is to "provide for an attractive, interesting, and convenient downtown as a place to do business, work, shop, reside, visit, socialize, and celebrate the community, and

**WHEREAS,** the Redmond Urban Area Planning Commission conducted public workshops and six public hearings (May 5, 2008, May 19, 2008, June 2, 2008, June 16, 2008, June 23, 2008, and July 7, 2008) to take oral and written testimony on the proposed revisions to Article I – Zoning Standards, Article IV – Site and Design Review Standards, and Article V – Signage Standards; and

WHEREAS, after receiving public testimony and deliberating the proposed amendments to Article I, Article IV and Article V, the Planning Commission recommended that the City Council approve the proposed amendments to Article I – Zoning Standards, Article IV – Site and Design Review Standards, and Article V – Signage Standards, as set forth in Exhibit A along with the findings set forth in Exhibit B; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed amendments will allow for Daily Display Signs with the appropriate standards, all existing Daily Display Signs will not be grandfathered by the adoption of this ordinance, and will need to comply with the amended code within ninety days of adoption in terms of standards, locations and practices, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that in the adoption of this ordinance, supporting findings, and accompanying code language is in the best interest of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, additional editing and refinement may again be necessary after adoption of this Zoning Code update, and the Council intends to have additional public hearings and to make subsequent amendment:

### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF REDMOND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE:** ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE 2008-14. Ordinance No. 2008 - 14, an ordinance amending Chapter 8, Development Regulations, Article I – Zoning Standards, Article IV – Site and Design Review Standards, Article V – Signage Standards, is hereby adopted amending the existing code as shown in Exhibit "A", supported by the findings attached as "Exhibit "B".

**SECTION TWO: PUBLIC HEARINGS.** In support of this update, the Redmond Planning Commission held a public hearing on May 5, 2008, May 19, 2008, June 2, 2008, June 16, 2008, June 23, 2008, and July 7, 2008 and the City Council held a public hearing on August 12, 2008 and August 26, 2008, and September 23, 2008 to take testimony and evidence on the Zoning Code and possible revisions or refinements to the documents adopted in this ordinance.

**SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this ordinance are severable. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given without such invalid part or parts.

SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE - November 14, 2008
