Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Saturday, May 16, 2009

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

CITY OF REDMOND ORDINANCE NO. 2008-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8 - DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, ARTICLE V - SIGN STANDARDS, SECTION 8.4240, 'BILLBOARDS', AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Redmond Development Code, Article V - Sign Standards, Section 8.4240 regulating billboards in the City of Redmond prohibits installation of billboards on public right-of-way and does not address the installation of billboards in relation to intersections of arterial, collector, and highways, and

WHEREAS, the City Council had determined that the existing regulations need to be amended to broaden the public right-of-way available for installation of billboards, and to regulate the installation of billboards in areas of arterial, collector, and highway intersection.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF REDMOND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE 2008-21. Ordinance No. 2008-21, an ordinance amending Chapter 8, Development Regulations, Article V - Sign Standards to amend section 8.4240 as follows:

[Words struck through are deleted and words with italics are added]:

4. All billboards shall be installed outside of the public right-of-way. Billboards may be installed on public or private property, subject to the consent of the property owner, and city approval based on the City's evaluation of traffic safety issues resulting from the billboard. No billboard shall be installed within any transportation right-of-way.

SECTION TWO: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given without such invalid part or parts.

SECTION THREE: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. The City Council of the City of Redmond finds that the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Redmond, includes the need for the City to regulate the installation of billboards in a manner to protect the safe mobility of vehicles. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by the Council, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the time of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED by the City Council and **APPROVED** by the Mayor this 28th day of October, 2008.

CITY OF REDMOND ORDINANCE NO. 2008-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8 - DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, ARTICLE V - SIGN STANDARDS, BILLBOARDS.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Redmond Development Code, Article V - Sign Standards regulates signs in the City of Redmond, including billboards and,

WHEREAS, the City Council and Urban Area Planning Commission initiated amendments to the Redmond Development Code, Article V – Sign Standards related to the types, procedures and standards to relocate billboards and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that in the adoption of this ordinance, supporting findings, and accompanying Redmond Development Code amendments are in the best interest of the City of Redmond.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF REDMOND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE 2008-23. Ordinance No. 2008-23, an ordinance amending Chapter 8, Development Regulations, Article V – Sign Standards is hereby adopted amending the existing code as shown in Exhibit "A", supported by the findings attached as "Exhibit "B".

SECTION TWO: PUBLIC HEARINGS. In support of these amendments, the Urban Area Planning Commission held a public hearing on November 17, 2008 and the City Council held a public hearing on December 9, 2008 to accept testimony and evidence on the amendments and possible revisions or refinements to the documents adopted in this ordinance.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given without such invalid part or parts.

SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE – January 8, 2009
