Appeal Procedures\*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Thursday, January 07, 2010

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45-day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

## ORDINANCE NO. 3322

# AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT AND LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENT AMENDING ARTICLE 30 FLOODPLAIN OVERLAY

WHEREAS, the Roseburg Urban Area Comprehensive Plan was adopted by the City Council in Ordinance No. 2345, effective on July 1, 1982, and re-adopted in Ordinance No. 2980 on December 9, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Roseburg Land Use and Development Ordinance No. 2363, was originally adopted July 1, 1984, and re-adopted in Ordinance No. 2981 on December 9, 1996, establishing procedures for hearing Comprehensive Plan Amendment; Zone Changes, and Text Amendments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseburg is a participating community in and supports the National Flood Insurance Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on File No. CPA-09-4/LUD-09-2, after a duly and timely notice.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission adopted Findings of Fact supporting a recommendation to approve the amendments identified herein; and

# NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ROSEBURG ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The City Council hereby takes official notice of the Planning Commission Findings of Fact and Decision dated November 2, 2009, recommending approval of Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map Amendment and Land Use and Development Ordinance Text Amendment.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> By reference herein the City Council hereby adopts the Planning Commission Findings of Fact and Decision as their own.

SECTION 3. Based on the evaluation detailed in the November 2, 2009, Planning Commission Staff Report and information considered through the public hearing process it has been determined that the proposal conforms the City of Roseburg Urban Area Comprehensive Plan and applicable Statewide Planning Goals.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby approves the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map Amendment and Land Use and Development Ordinance Text Amendment as detailed in Exhibits 1, 2 and 3 of the Findings of Fact.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> The City Recorder, at the request of, or with the concurrence of the City Attorney, is authorized to administratively correct any reference errors contained herein or in other provisions of the Roseburg Municipal Code and/or the Roseburg Urban Area Comprehensive Plan as amended by the provisions added, amended or repealed herein.

#### Finding No. 1

This matter came before the Planning Commission for public hearing on November 2, 2009, in the Council Chambers of Roseburg City Hall, 900 SE Douglas Avenue, Roseburg, Oregon.

## Finding No. 2

The application was duly executed as provided in the Land Use and Development Ordinance.

## Finding No. 3

Notice of the public hearing was mailed to affected property owners a minimum of 20 days before the public hearing and notice was given by publication in the News-Review, a newspaper of general circulation, at least 10 days prior to the date of the hearing. Opportunities were provided for all interested parties to be involved in the planning process through the public hearing.

# Finding No. 4

The Planning Commission takes official notice of the Roseburg Urban Area Comprehensive Plan adopted by City Council Ordinance No. 2980 on December 9, 1996 and of the Roseburg Land Use and Development Ordinance No. 2363, as originally adopted July 1, 1984, and re-adopted in Ordinance No. 2981 on December 9, 1996, as both may have been amended from time-to-time. The Planning Commission takes official notice of the records of the Community Development Department.

# Finding No. 5

The subject area is defined as those properties affected by floodplain within the corporate boundaries of the City of Roseburg.

#### Finding No. 6

The Planning Commission staff report prepared for evaluation of this application was reviewed and taken into consideration during the review process including all exhibits and materials referenced and hereby made a part of the Commission's findings.

# CONCLUSION

The adoption of the DFIRMs and the Flood Insurance Study as presented ensures the City of Roseburg remains a participating community in good standing with the National Flood Insurance Program. Further, implementation of the LUDO amendments will provide more accurate floodplain management for the citizens of Roseburg.

BASED ON THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THE STAFF REPORT, AS WELL AS ALL OTHER MATERIALS PRESENTED, INCLUDING RELEVANT PUBLIC INPUT, THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDS THE CITY COUNCIL **APPROVE** FILE NO. CPA-09-4/LUDO-09-2 ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND THE LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE ARTICLE 30, FLOODPLAIN OVERLAY AND ADOPTION OF THE FLOOD INSURANCE STUDY (FIS) AND DIGITAL FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAPS (DFIRMS) FOR DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON AND INCORPORATED AREAS.


