This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

\*NOTE: The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local

government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. No LUBA Notification to the jurisdiction of an appeal by the deadline, this Plan Amendment is acknowledged.

#### Ordinance No. 3016

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 14 OF THE COTTAGE GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.7.300 RIPARIAN DEVELOPMENT

#### THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Riparian Development section of the Cottage Grove Development Code to comply with Statewide Planning Goal 5 requirements for Riparian safe harbor (OAR 660-015), which requires protection for all fish-bearing streams and wetlands identified on acknowledged Local Wetland Inventories.

Section 2. <u>Bennett Creek</u>. Bennett Creek is one of four fish-bearing streams in Cottage Grove's UGB, but was not identified in Riparian Development Section 3.7.300 of the Cottage Grove Development Code. Additionally, the Department of State Lands has acknowledged a local wetlands inventory map for the City of Cottage Grove, which supersedes the National Wetlands Inventory Map per OAR 660-015 and the City of Cottage Grove Comprehensive Plan.

Section 3. <u>Findings.</u> City Council with the adoption of this Ordinance hereby adopts the findings as detailed in "Exhibit A".

Section 4. <u>Procedural Compliance.</u> This amendment is in compliance with 14.4.7.500-600 of the Municipal Code of the City of Cottage Grove and is based upon the City Council determination, after a Planning Commission public hearing and recommendation, that this amendment is a proper implementation of the comprehensive land use plan and, therefore, is in the public interest and for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cottage Grove.

Section 5. <u>Amendment.</u> Sections 3.7.300 (A) & (C) of the Cottage Grove Development Code are hereby amended as read as follows:

### 3.7.300 Riparian Development

"3.7.300(A) Applicability. The following standards are applicable to lands Adjacent to the Coast Fork of the Willamette River, Row River, Silk Creek and Bennett Creek. This section applies the standards and specific rules for riparian safe harbors as established in OAR 660-023. The requirements of this section are in addition to other provisions of this code, and will be enforced as part of Land Use, Site Review,or other development review. If riparian modifications occur that are not associated with a development project, these standards shall be enforced through a Type II application.

3.7.300(C) Riparian Corridor Boundary. Along all riparian areas identified in the adopted Goal 5 Riparian Resource Inventory, the riparian corridor

boundary shall be 50 feet from top of bank.

When the riparian corridor includes all or portions of a significant wetland as Defined by the acknowledged Local Wetland Inventory map, the standard distance to the riparian corridor boundary shall be measured from, and include, the upland edge of he wetland."

#### EXHIBIT 'A' TO ORDINANCE 3016

- 1. City of Cottage Grove made an application to amend Section 3.7.300 A & C, Riparian Development in the Cottage Grove Development Code in order to add 'Bennett Creek' to the list of fish bearing streams in Section 3.7.300 (A) and to change the reference from National Wetland Inventory to Local Wetland Inventory in Section 3.7.300 C.
- Notice of the proposed amendment was provided to the Department of Land Conservation and Development 45 days prior to the first evidentiary hearing pursuant to ORS 197.610 and OAR 660-018-000.
- 3. The proposed amendments are in compliance with Section 4.1.500 H:
  - a. The amendments are consistent with the Statewide Planning Goals. In particular Goal 1 Public Involvement: opportunities have been provided to obtain public input; Goal 2 Land Use Planning: by bringing the code into compliance based on new information; and Goal 5 Natural resources: the City has utilized the Safe harbor approach with riparian corridors and requires all ODFW listed fish bearing streams be identified in the code.
  - b. The amendments are consistent with the Comprehensive Plan.
  - c. The code changes do not affect the provision of public services, but only clarify and implement the intent of the state law to protect identified wetlands and riparian areas. Section 4.1.500 H (3) does not apply.
- 4. A public hearing was held before the Planning Commission on September 21, 2011 where the Planning Commission recommended approval to the City Council.
- 5. A public hearing was held before the City Council on November 28, 2011.
- 6. The proposed amendments are in compliance with Section 4.7.500-600 of the Cottage Development Code.
- 7. The amendments are the proper implementation of the comprehensive land use plan.
- 8. The amendments are in the public interest and for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cottage Grove.
