This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

\*NOTE: The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to

DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. No LUBA Notification to the jurisdiction of an appeal by the deadline, this Plan Amendment is acknowledged.

### Ordinance No.632-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NYSSA ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO NYSSA'S TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN AND ZONING CODE (TITLE XI) AND RELATED FINDINGS.

WHEREAS, amendments to the Nyssa Transportation System Plan and Zoning Code are needed to address safety and livability issues raised by citizens of Nyssa in past local planning efforts and ensure continued compliance with the State of Oregon's Transportation Planning Rule (TPR); and

WHEREAS, the Nyssa City Council and Planning Commission held a work session on June 15, 2011, to consider the amendments and receive public input; and

**WHEREAS**, the City sent notice of the proposed amendments to the Department of Land, Conservation, and Development on April 7, 2011, not less than 45 days prior to the first evidentiary hearing as required by state law and local code.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Nyssa does ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Nyssa Transportation System Plan's (TSP) is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A.

<u>Section 2</u>: The TSP and Zoning Code (Title XI) are amended as described in Exhibit B (Memorandum dated March 18, 2011, from Parametrix to the City of Nyssa), including amendments implementing the updated bicycle and pedestrian element of the TSP as well as ensuring continued compliance with the State Transportation Planning Rule (TPR).

Section 3: The Findings of Fact as shown in Exhibit C are hereby adopted in support of this decision.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The Common Council of the City of Nyssa hereby adjudges that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the said City that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution will be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 936-11**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NYSSA, MALHEUR COUNTY, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE SUBORDINATION OF LIENS AND JUDGMENT.

WHEREAS, ODOT has been working with the City of Nyssa in order to obtain permanent easements for sidewalks along Thunderegg Blvd for the US 20/26 – 11<sup>th</sup> Street – Idaho State Line project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Nyssa had placed a lien on property belonging to Van Draper on the corner of Thunderegg Blvd. and Locust Avenue; and
