Appeal Procedures\*

## DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: August 1, 2007

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

# CITY OF ELGIN ORDINANCE NO. 164 (2007) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING MAP

JUL 1 3 2007

LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS: The Elgin Planning Commission, on April 19, 2007, and the Elgin City Council, on May 8, 2007, have each held a public hearing regarding a petition to change the zoning map and;

WHEREAS: Both the Planning Commission and the City Council have recommended making a change to the zoning map as petitioned:

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ELGIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS,

## Section 1 ZONING CHANGED

The zoning map is hereby amended as follows: A parcel of 1.05 Acres known as Tax lot Twp 1N, Rng 39 15CB #2604 [Being a portion of lots 3 and 4 of Block 7 of Sommer's Addition] is here by re-zoned from Industrial-1 to Residential-1.

### Section 2. FINDINGS

The following findings are hereby adopted:

- 1 Residential use is compatible with existing surrounding uses;
- 2. The requested zone map change is consistent with the current R-1 boundaries;
- 3. There is adequate lands in this area to support Industrial uses,
- 4. The current and previous use as residential has had no detrimental effect on the uses of surrounding properties, either residential or industrial;
- 5. The access to this parcel is adequate for residential use but only marginal for light industrial use.

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## Section 3. SEVERABILITY

The sections and subsections of this ordinance are severable. The invalidity of a section or subsection shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections and subsections herein.

#### Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance becomes effective and in full force 30 days after its adoption by the City Council.
