Appeal Procedures\*

#### DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: May 27, 2008

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

\*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

### AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OPEN SPACE MAP AND INVENTORY INTO THE CITY OF WEST LINN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (PLN-07-04).

WHEREAS, Goal 5 of the City's Comprehensive Plan recognizes the importance of many of the City's natural resources, including its open spaces, and includes specific Polices and Action Measures requiring the completion of an inventory and mapping of these resources; and,

WHEREAS, Oregon Statewide Planning Goal 5 includes specific requirements for local governments to adopt inventories of open spaces; and,

WHEREAS, in 2003 the City commissioned and completed a preliminary inventory of open spaces in the City which was never adopted; and

WHEREAS, the open space inventory was updated by City Staff in 2008 in compliance with the Oregon guidelines for preparation of Goal 5 inventories, and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2008, the West Linn Planning Commission, held a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, upon a recommendation approval of from the City Staff, unanimously recommended that the City Council adopt the proposed Open Space Map and Inventory, as part of the West Linn Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the West Linn City Council held a public hearing on April 14, 2008, and adopted the findings justifying the adoption of the Open Space Map and Inventory as attached to this Ordinance;

#### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WEST LINN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Goal 5 of the City of West Linn Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include a new Figure 5-3 "Open Space Map and Inventory", attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit 'A'. Due to its size and detail, the official Open Space Map and Inventory shall be kept on file with the City of West Linn Planning Department and will be available for public inspection at no cost.

Section 2. Goal 5, Section 2 of the Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to accurately reflect the new Figure 5-3, as follows:

"The purpose of the natural resource section is to protect areas that are necessary to the long term health of the natural environment and local economy, such as mineral and aggregate resources, watersheds, fish and wildlife habitat areas, as well as ecological and scientific areas and open space (see Figures 5-1, and 5-2, and 5-3)."

#### ORDINANCE NO. 1563 WEST LINN, OREGON

## AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OPEN SPACE MAP AND INVENTORY INTO THE CITY OF WEST LINN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, Goal 5 of the City's Comprehensive Plan recognizes the importance of many of the City's natural resources, including its open spaces, and includes specific Polices and Action Measures requiring the completion of an inventory and mapping of these resources; and,

WHEREAS, Oregon Statewide Planning Goal 5 includes specific requirements for local governments to adopt inventories of open spaces; and,

WHEREAS, in 2003 the City commissioned and completed a preliminary inventory of open spaces in the City which was never adopted; and

WHEREAS, the open space inventory was updated by City Staff in 2008 in compliance with the Oregon guidelines for preparation of Goal 5 inventories; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2008, the West Linn Planning Commission, held a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, upon a recommendation of approval from the City Staff, unanimously recommended that the City Council adopt the proposed Open Space Map and Inventory, as part of the West Linn Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the West Linn City Council held a public hearing on April 14, 2008, and adopted the findings justifying the adoption of the Open Space Map and Inventory as attached to this Ordinance;

#### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WEST LINN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Goal 5 of the City of West Linn Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include a new Figure 5-3 "Open Space Map and Inventory," attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit 'A'. Due to its size and detail, the official Open Space Map and Inventory shall be kept on file with the City of West Linn Planning Department and will be available for public inspection at no cost.

Section 2. Goal 5, Section 2, of the Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to accurately reflect the new Figure 5-3, as follows:

"The purpose of the natural resource section is to protect areas that are necessary to the long term health of the natural environment and local economy, such as mineral and aggregate resources, watersheds, fish and wildlife habitat areas, as well as ecological and scientific areas and open space (see Figures 5-1, and 5-2, and 5-3)."


