ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ARLINGTON ZONING ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A TEMPORARY CONDITIONAL USE PERMITTING PROCESS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS

The City is experiencing a severe shortage of temporary housing availability, and in order to respond to this identified need, has determined the best course of action is to amend the City's Zoning Ordinance to establish a process for issuance of Temporary Conditional Use Permits.

Now Therefore: The City of Arlington hereby ordains:

The following language is added to the City's Zoning Ordinance as Section 5.1(10)

SECTION 5.1 (10) TEMPORARY CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

- (1) Purpose: The City of Arlington was one of the first jurisdictions to be acknowledged for being in Compliance with the Statewide Planning Goals, in 1978. The City has always maintained an active and responsive Land Use Planning Program. From time to time, land use issues arise that have no simple solutions, but where immediate action is required. The City has determined that the use of a Temporary Conditional Use Permit would provide the means to resolve citywide issues that are anticipated to be short-term in nature. Such is the case now, in the early part of 2009, as the City finds a significant shortage of short-term housing to meet temporary housing needs. The solution that best fits the city is a short-term one that will sunset at the end of this specific need. The City does not wish to amend its Zoning Ordinance to affect a long-term change in the City's Land Use, but recognizes a short-term solution must follow a well defined process. Therefore, a Temporary Conditional Use procedure is judged to be the best solution for the City. Now, there may be other issues, over time, which require an immediate response by the City. The following criteria must be met:
- 1. The City Council must adopt a Resolution outlining the issue to be addressed and the basic standards that will govern the temporary use of the land. The Resolution must indicate the emergency is Citywide.
- 2. The Resolution shall direct the Planning Commission to adopt siting standards for the land use being considered.
- 3. Generally, an Administrative Review Process is acceptable if all TCUP standards adopted by the Planning Commission are met by the applicant. A quasi-judicial public hearing must be conducted when the standards are not met by the applicant.

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4. The approval criteria shall be the same as that of a Conditional Use Permit, shown in Section 5.1(2).

EMERGENCY CLAUSE

This ordinance being enacted by the Common Council in the exercise of its police power and for the purpose of meeting an emergency, and being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon being enacted.
