Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: November 13, 2006

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review 45 days prior to adoption. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE ABOVE DATE SPECIFIED.

FINAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Ruth Bowen, applicant, requested approval of an amendment of the COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN MAP from Non-Resource (NR) to Rural Residential (RR); and a CHANGE OF ZONE from Non-Resource (NR) to Rural Residential (R-10) for one parcel totaling 20.0± acres; and,

WHEREAS, the COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN MAP AMENDMENT and ZONE CHANGE would provide for the development of two 10-acre parcels if all applicable provisions of the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Code are met; and;

WHEREAS, the use proposed is to provide consistency identified in Land Use Planning Goal 10 Housing and the opportunities associated for the community and surrounding area; and,

WHEREAS, the Klamath County Planning Department provided proper notice of public hearings held, on September 26, 2006, before the Klamath County Planning Commission and Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, the Klamath County Planning Commission concluded the proposed changes are consistent with or can be made consistent with the COMPREHENSIVE PLAN subject to imposition with and compliance to all requirements of Federal, State, and Local law, statutes, rules, and policies; including but not limited to, standards of the Oregon Building Code; the Oregon Fire Code; the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Code; and, the Klamath County Public Works standards, policies and procedures; and, without unique or specified Conditions of Approval; and,

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2006, based on testimony entered and consideration of Proposed Findings of Fact identified within the Staff Report, the Klamath County Planning Commission, upon adoption of said Findings of Fact, find the application is in conformance with Articles 47 and 48 of the Klamath County Land Development Code and Comprehensive Plan, recommended approval of File Number CLUP/ZC 20-06 to the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2006, based on testimony entered and consideration of Findings of Fact adopted by the Klamath County Planning Commission and upon a unanimous recommendation for approval, the Board of County Commissioners approved the request of File Number CLUP/ZC 20-06, subject to imposition with and compliance to all requirements of Federal, State, and Local law, statutes, rules, and policies; including but not limited to, standards of the Oregon Building Code; the Oregon Fire Code; the Klamath County Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Code; and, the Klamath County Public Works standards, policies and procedures; without unique and specified additional Conditions of Approval; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSONERS OF KLAMATH COUNTY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The Klamath County Comprehensive Land Use Plan Map is amended to include:

TOWNSHIP 39 South, RANGE 10 East, SECTION 12DB, TAX LOT 00100 (20.0± acres) as a Rural Residential (RR) designation; and,

The Klamath County Zoning Map is amended to include:

TOWNSHIP 39 South, RANGE 10 East, SECTION 12DB, TAX LOT 00100 (20.0± acres) as a Rural Residential (R-10) zoning designation.
