Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR DEADLINE TO APPEAL: July 7, 2008

This amendment was not submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption. Pursuant to OAR 660-18-060, the Director or any person is eligible to appeal this action to LUBA under ORS 197.830 to 197.845.

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

1. NATURE OF THE REQUEST

The applicant has applied for a conditional use permit to provide for a 160 acre template test forest dwelling on an 80 acre parcel in a forestry range zoning district. This request is reviewed for conformance with the Klamath County Land Development Code (KCLDC) Articles 24; 44; 55; and 55.080.

2. HEARING PARTICIPANTS

This matter came before hearings officer David P. Groff on May 16, 2008. Shanna Done, Planner, appeared and represented the planning department, and recommended approval of the application. No one testified in opposition to the CUP.

3. PROPERTY

The property is located 7.5 miles north and 1.5 miles west from the junction of state highways 97 and 58.

4. MATERIALS CONSIDERED

The hearings officer considered all testimony received on the record, in addition to the staff report and its exhibits.

5. FINDINGS

The hearings officer makes the following findings:

Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the applicant's request for a conditional use permit is APPROVED, subject to conditions 1 through 5, set out in the staff report, page 8.

Notice of Appeal Rights

You are hereby notified that this Order may be appealed to the Klamath County Board of Commissioners by filing with the Klamath County Planning Department a Notice of Appeal as set out in Section 33.004 of the Klamath County Land Development Code, together with the fee required, *within seven (7) days* of the mailing of this order. Failure to file a notice of appeal within the time allowed will result in loss of your right to appeal this decision.

CONCLUSION

The Applicant's request for a Forest Template Dwelling on 80 acres of land zoned Forestry (more particularly described as Tax Map Number R-2508-005D0-00100-000) is deemed appropriate for development as related to land use. Other review may be required to meet building, public works, and other agency regulations and requirements.

Based on review of the subject application and additional evidence submitted to the record, staff recommends the Hearings Officer **APPROVE** the Applicant's request, subject to Federal and State law, rules, or policy; Klamath County Land Development Code and County Ordinances; Oregon Fire Codes and Appendices; Oregon Building Codes and Appendices; Klamath County Public Works Standards, Policies and Procedures; and additional Conditions of Approval, as described below:

- Prior to application of development permits, the owner shall record a restrictive covenant with the deed recognizing the rights of adjacent and nearby landowners to conduct farm and forest operations consistent with accepted farm practices and the Oregon Forest Practices Act. Evidence of recordation of said covenant shall be submitted to the Planning Department prior to authorization of development by the Planning Department.
- 2. Prior to application for site development permits, the applicant must record a deed covenant that will run with the land imposes fire siting standards as outlined in Article 69 of the KCLDC.
- 3. Prior to application for building permits, obtain permits from Klamath County On-Site Sanitation for the septic system and any permits required for an on-site well from the State Watermaster's office.
- 4. This Conditional Use Permit shall be void after 4 years if development has not been initiated through a building permit issued in reliance on this approval. If the building permit expires prior to actual site development, this CUP may also be declared void.
- 5. This Conditional Use Permit will be limited to one (1) two-year time extension.
