The Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) received the attached notice of adoption. Copies of the adopted plan amendment are available for review at DLCD offices in Salem, the applicable field office, and at the local government office.

Appeal Procedures*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: February 5, 2008

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption with less than the required 45day notice. Pursuant to ORS 197.830 (2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.

WHEREAS pursuant to Chapter 660, Division 12, of the Oregon Administrative Rules, and specifically OAR 660-12-0045, Umatilla County, as part of its Comprehensive Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 2002-03, a Transportation System Plan for Umatilla County; and

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Transportation System Plan ("TSP") is to guide the management of existing transportation facilities and the design and the implementation of future facilities for the next 20 years; and

WHEREAS in 2003, the Oregon Department of Transportation designated a portion of Highway 730 in Umatilla County, from the western county line to the western city limits of the City of Umatilla as a Safety Corridor;

WHEREAS the Oregon Department of Transportation sought a US 730 Corridor Refinement Plan to identify circulation and accessmanagement strategies that would address the corridor's near and long-term safety needs;

WHEREAS Kittelson & Associates, Inc. developed and prepared the attached US 730 Corridor Refinement Plan, dated October, 2007;

WHEREAS the Oregon Department of Transportation requested that Umatilla County adopt the US 730 Corridor Refinement Plan as part of the TSP;

WHEREAS, at its December 13, 2007 meeting, the Umatilla County Planning Commission reviewed the proposed plan and recommended that the Board of Commissioners accept the report and adopt the report at a part of the TSP;

WHEREAS the Board of Commissions held a public hearing on January 8, 2008, to consider the plan;

WHEREAS at its meeting of January 8, 2008, the Board of Commissioners voted unanimously to accept the plan and amend the TSP.

NOW, THEREFORE the Board of Commissioners of Umatilla County ordains that the US 730 Corridor Refinement Plan, dated October 2007, is accepted, and the Umatilla County Transportation System Plan and the Umatilla County Comprehensive Plan are amended to include the US 730 Corridor Refinement Plan, dated October, 2007. A copy of the US 730 Corridor Refinement Plan is attached to this ordinance and incorporated by this reference.
