### **DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT OR DEADLINE TO APPEAL: August 13, 2010**

This amendment was not submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption because the jurisdiction determined that emergency circumstances required expedited review. Pursuant to OAR 660-18-060, the Director or any person is eligible to appeal this action to LUBA under ORS 197.830 to 197.845.

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

**\*NOTE: THE APPEAL DEADLINE IS BASED UPON THE DATE THE DECISION WAS MAILED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. A DECISION MAY HAVE BEEN MAILED TO YOU ON A DIFFERENT DATE THAN IT WAS MAILED TO DLCD. AS A RESULT YOUR APPEAL DEADLINE MAY BE EARLIER THAN THE DATE SPECIFIED ABOVE.**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CROOK COUNTY ORDINANCE 229 TO EXTEND ITS SUNSET CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY	ORDINANCE NO. 233
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WHEREAS, The County Court wishes to extend the Sunset Clause of Ordinance 229 by one hundred-twenty days; and

WHEREAS, The extension will allow time for further discussion and public input that will allow the County Court to make a more informed decision;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Crook County Court ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION ONE. ORDINANCE 229 is hereby modified to read that the Sunset Clause that was set to expire at 11:59 p.m. on October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 is now to expire at 11:59 p.m. on February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

SECTION TWO. *Emergency.* This Ordinance being necessary for the health, welfare and safety of the people of Crook County, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall become effective upon signing.
