Appeal Procedures\*

DLCD ACKNOWLEDGMENT or DEADLINE TO APPEAL: Monday, August 16, 2010

This amendment was submitted to DLCD for review prior to adoption pursuant to ORS 197.830(2)(b) only persons who participated in the local government proceedings leading to adoption of the amendment are eligible to appeal this decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

If you wish to appeal, you must file a notice of intent to appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) no later than 21 days from the date the decision was mailed to you by the local government. If you have questions, check with the local government to determine the appeal deadline. Copies of the notice of intent to appeal must be served upon the local government and others who received written notice of the final decision from the local government. The notice of intent to appeal must be served and filed in the form and manner prescribed by LUBA, (OAR Chapter 661, Division 10). Please call LUBA at 503-373-1265, if you have questions about appeal procedures.

- \*<u>NOTE:</u> The Acknowledgment or Appeal Deadline is based upon the date the decision was mailed by local government. A decision may have been mailed to you on a different date than it was mailed to DLCD. As a result, your appeal deadline may be earlier than the above date specified. <u>NO LUBA</u> Notification to the jurisdiction of an appeal by the deadline, this Plan Amendment is acknowledged.

NOTICE OF DECISION July 26, 2010

This notice is to inform you that on July 21, 2010, the Morrow County Court adopted Ordinance Number MC-04-2010 amending the Morrow County Comprehensive Plan, Comprehensive Plan Map and Zoning Ordinance Map. Specifically Morrow County added a Goal 5 significant aggregate resource site to the Comprehensive Plan list of significant aggregate sites, identified the location on the Comprehensive Plan Map, and applied the Significant Resource Overlay Zone to the site on the Zoning Ordinance Map.

The requirements for filing an appeal of the decision to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) are set forth in ORS 197.830 to 197.845. State law and associated administrative rules promulgated by LUBA describe the period within which any appeal must be filed and the manner in which such an appeal must be commenced. Presently, ORS 197.830(9) requires that a notice of intent to appeal plan or land use regulation amendments adopted pursuant to ORS 197.610 to 197.625 "shall be filed not later than 21 days after notice of the decision sought to be reviewed is mailed or otherwise submitted to parties entitled to notice under ORS 197.615." Notice of this decision was mailed on July 26, 2010. The deadline to appeal is August 16, 2010.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MORROW COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO INCLUDE A GOAL 5 SIGNIFICANT AGGREGATE RESOURCE SITE AND AMEND THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND ZONING MAPS TO APPLY THE SIGNIFICANT RESOURCE OVERLAY ZONE

COUNTY ORDINANCE

NO. MC-CH-BCIC

WHEREAS, ORS 203.035 authorizes Morrow County to exercise authority within the county over matters of County concern; and

WHEREAS, Morrow County adopted a Comprehensive Land Use Plan which was acknowledged by the Land Conservation and Development Commission on January 15, 1986; and

WHEREAS, an application was filed by Marty Britt on land owned by Sidney and Randy Britt to include approximately 40 acres of land as a Goal 5 significant resource site, to add the site to the Morrow County Comprehensive Plan Inventory of Significant Aggregate Sites, apply the Significant Resource Overlay Zone to the site, and to allow mining; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission held a hearing to review the request on April 27, 2010 at Heppner City Hall in Heppner, Oregon and on May 25, 2010 at the Port of Morrow Riverfront Center in Boardman, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission found the aggregate site significant and did not identify conflicting uses and recommended approval of the request and adopted Planning Commission Final Findings of Fact; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court held a hearing to consider the recommendation of the Morrow County Planning Commission on June 23, 2010, at the Morrow County Courthouse in Heppner, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court affirmed that the proposed aggregate site meets the requirements under Oregon Administrative Rule whereby a site is estimated to provide more than 500,000 tons of aggregate material and the soils contain less than 35 percent of soils classified as Class | or II; and

WHEREAS, a representative set of samples of aggregate material in the deposit on the proposed site of this application meets Oregon Department of Transportation specifications for base rock for air degradation, abrasion, and soundness; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court deemed the site at the subject property a Goal 5 significant aggregate site.

#### Section 1 Title of Ordinance:

This Ordinance shall be known, and may be cited, as the "2010 Britt Aggregate Goal 5 Significant Site Comprehensive Plan, Comprehensive Plan Map and Zoning Map Amendment."

#### Section 2 Affected Documents:

The Comprehensive Plan, Comprehensive Plan Map and Zoning Map are amended.

- 1. <u>Text Amendment:</u> Insert the following on page 102 of the Comprehensive Plan: Site/Permit Number To be provided by DOGAMI Type of Material: Quarry Rock County Zone Designation: EFU Remarks: None Goal 5 Designation: N/A
- 2. <u>Map Amendments</u>: The Comprehensive Plan Aggregate Resources Map will be amended to indicate the site as an aggregate site. The Zoning Map will be amend by applying the Significant Resource Overlay Zone. Both maps will be amended as shown on the attached Impact Area map.

#### Section 3\_Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective on August 1, 2010.


